## Latest Breaking News

Accomodation: Contracts for our hotel and lodging provider have been finalized. The lodging link has been added on to the zone website and will be emailed to our list of contacts. **OMP**: 17 rooms (1 per LSC) have been reserved for the **officials mentoring program.** Our Meet and National Evaluator Ron VanPool will offer officials training Tuesday Aug. 9<sup>th</sup> from 6:30pm to 8:30pm in Olympic oval world record lounge.

Social Media Torch Run: Given this is an Olympic year we are anticipating significant media interest in the event which allows us to promote the sport. In January we hope to launch a social media campaign to include a Torch Run. (Follow The Raptor) We are hoping to include all members of the Western Zone, not just those planning to attend this meet. We will release information and instructions about the Torch Run in December. The general idea is that during the 17 weeks prior to the event we will highlight one WZ LSC each week using social media. During this week, members of the LSC are encouraged to post pictures at different places in their LSC and share what makes their LSC great. We are hoping to have an event mascot design poster that can be emailed. People can then take selfies at meets with it anytime and post during their highlight week.

**Opening Ceremonies:** We are still considering doing a short gathering Tuesday evening for athletes, coaches and chaperones to welcome everyone to Utah and get them excited about the meet. We hope we can bring in a motivational speaker (former Olympian) and have a fun and engaging event for the swimmers. If this idea goes ahead teams may have the option to purchase box dinners to be delivered to the pool prior to the Opening Ceremonies.
