	 The 50-meter competition pool with bulkhead offers two eight lane 25-yard competition pools with a depth of 6.7 feet to 12 feet from end to end with overflow gutters with non-turbulent lane lines. 							
	All sessions will be run in a 25-yard competition pool configured for eight lanes. Two courses may be used based on number of entries.							
	Indoor six lane, 25-yard pool for continuous warm-up, cool-down.							
	 Competitor starting blocks, CTS6 with automatic and semi-automatic timing, backup Dolphin wireless stopwatches. 							
	The competition course has been certified in accordance with current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 104.2.2C(4). A copy of the certification is on file with USA Swimming							
	There will be lifeguards and additional Aquatics staff along with 2 AED located on the opposite sides of the pool deck.							
	To provide parents/guardians who are outside of the facility the ability to view their athletes' events, this meet may be video streamed following all MAAPP guidelines. 	 Based on the number of entries received, the Meet Director reserves the right to configure the pool in two-25-yard course. Teams will be notified by no later than Saturday, November 4, 2023 if two courses will be used. 						
ENTRIES:	DEADLINE FOR THE RECEIPT OF ENTRIES IS TUESDAY, OCTOBER 31, 2023.						
	Entries must be submitted in SCY (course) times using Commlink-2 software. Teams submit entries via email.						
	 A printout of entries must be included or the meet checklist/summary sheet with the name of the person to contact in case of questions must accompany the entries. 						
	 Coach Time (CT) and "No Time" (NT) entries will be accepted for events in which a swimmer does not have a time of record. <u>CT must be slower than an "A" time</u>. All entry times other than CT must have been achieved in USA Swimming sanctioned, approved, or observed competition. 						
	 Swimmers may enter a maximum of Four individual events per Day. There is an exception for the 8 and Under session on Saturday, which will be capped at 5 events. 						
	 Entries will be processed in the order received and <u>accepted to</u> the greatest extent possible without exceeding the 4-hour/session timeline limit.

SEEDING:	A Clerk of Course will be provided for 8 & Younger swimmers at the Saturday Session.						
	A member of Clerk of Course will walk the 8 and under swimmers to their appropriate lane behind the blocks for their event.						
	Swimmers in the morning sessions should report directly to the blocks for their events.						
	Swimmers in the afternoon sessions should report directly to the blocks for their events.						
	All events will be pre-seeded.						
	 Coaches will be asked to submit scratches for events #13, #14, #41, #42, #55, #56, #73, and #74 (400 IM and 500 Free) no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the session. At the discretion of the meet referee, the events will be reseeded if sufficient scratches are received. 						
	• Events #13, #14, #41, #42, #55, #56, #73, and #74 (400 IM and 500 Free) will be swum fastest to slowest and alternating heats of girls and boys unless two pools are used. If two pools are used, such events will still be swam fastest to slowest.						
WARM-UP:	Morning sessions: Warm-ups no earlier than 7:00am; competition starts at 8:10am. on Saturday and 8:00 am on Sunday						
	Mid-session 8 and under: Warm up will start no earlier than 11:30am; competition will start no earlier than 12:00pm						
	Afternoon session: Saturday Warm-ups will start no earlier than 1:00pm; competition starts not earlier than 2pm.						
	Afternoon session: Sunday Warm-ups will start no earlier than 11:30am; competition starts not before 12:30pm.						
	Distance Events (500 free and 400 IM): The pool will be opened for not less than 10 minutes of open warm-ups immediately following the finish of the relays, with the distance events						

	competitions starting not less than 5 minutes thereafter or the estimated time posted, whichever is later.					
	Lane assignment and warm-up times for individual clubs will be posted on the Prince William Swim Club website www.pwscamberjax.org no later than Tuesday, November 7, 2023 and will also be emailed to the contact person of the participating clubs.					
	If the morning session runs late, afternoon warm-ups will begin immediately after the morning session ends.					
AWARDS:	No awards will be given					
RULES:	The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations including the Minor Athlete Abuse Protection Policy will govern this meet.					
	 All adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (MAAPP) and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. 					
	Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA-S member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.					
	 Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present without written USA Swimming approval. 					
	Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. In addition, photography behind the blocks is not permitted.					
	Changing, in whole or in part, into or out of swimsuit when wearing just one suit in an area other than in a locker room, bathroom, or other space designated for changing is PROHIBITED.					
	 In according with Virginia Swimming Best Practices, all athletes should shower before entering the pool. 					
	 An athlete suspected of sustaining a concussion or exhibiting signs of a concussion, will immediately be removed from competition and shall not return to competition that day. The athlete may return to competition on a subsequent day, but only with a release authorization signed by a licensed healthcare provider. 					
	 In accordance with Virginia Swimming Policy, only those coaches who have current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches with expired or non-current credentials will be required to leave the deck area. 					
PENALTIES:	A fine of up to \$100 per event may be assessed for any illegal participation in the meet. Illegal participation is defined as

	Athlete competed in the incorrect age group.					
	 Athlete is not registered with USA Swimming prior to the first day of the meet. 					
	If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer. And a second in the swimmer is the second of the swimmer.
