FACILITY:	
	<ul> <li>The outdoor 50-meter competition pool offers two-25-yard competition pools with a depth of 6'-7" at the deep end and 4'-6" at the shallow end. The pool has overflow gutters; non-turbulent lane markers, Paragon starting blocks and Colorado Timing System.</li> <li>All sessions will be run in the 25-yard competition pool will set up in the deep end using up to 10 lanes.</li> <li>The competition course has been certified in accordance with current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 104.2.2C(4). Certification is on file with USA Swimming</li> <li>Princess Anne YMCA has an AED on site, lifeguards that will be staffed during the meet, and access to medical supplies should they be needed.</li> </ul>

ELIGIBILITY:	<ul> <li>Open to all TIDE Swimming athletes who are ages 8 and over that are registered before the first day of the meet.</li> <li>No on deck Virginia Swimming athlete registration will be permitted.</li> <li>Any 12 and Under athlete swimming the 500 Free must have a time of record in the 200 Free that is a B time or faster in their respective age group.</li> <li>Any 12 and Under athlete swimming the 400lM must have a time of record in the 200lM that is a B time or faster in their respective age group.</li> <li>Any athlete swimming the 1,000 Free or the 1,650 Free must have a time of record in either the 500 Free, 1,000 Free, or the 1,650 Free that is a B time or faster in their respective age group</li> <li>2021-2024 NAG time standards are in effect.</li> <li>Age on November 18, 2023 will determine age for the entire meet.</li> </ul>
DISABILITY	Athletes with a disability are welcome and shall provide advance notice of desired
SWIMMERS:	<ul> <li>accommodations to the Meet Director.</li> <li>The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to the competition.</li> </ul>
FORMAT:	<ul> <li>All events will be swum fastest to slowest.</li> <li>The meet director reserves the right to limit the 1,650 free event to 8 heats</li> <li>The meet director reserves the right to limit the 1,000 free event to 4 heats</li> <li>The meet director reserves the right to limit the 500 Free event to 12 heats</li> <li>The meet director reserves the right to limit the 400IM event to 10 heats</li> <li>The meet director reserves the right to combine heats during the meet</li> </ul>
WARM-UP:	<ul> <li>First session warmups will be from 7:00-7:30am; with competition starting at 7:40am.</li> <li>Second Session warmups will be no earlier than 11:45am; with competition starting at 12:25pm.</li> <li>When competition begins there will be 10 lanes available for warmup and warm down during competition as well.</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Coach Time (CT) and "No Time" (NT) entries will be accepted for events in which a swimmer</li> </ul>		
	does not have a time of record. CT must be slower than an "A" time. All entry times other than		
	CT must have been achieved in USA Swimming sanctioned, approved, or observed competition.		
	Swimmers may enter a maximum of 1 individual event		
	Entries will be processed in the order received and accepted to the greatest extent possible		
	without exceeding the 4-hour/session timeline limit or the limits as mandated by current		
	Commonwealth of Virginia guidelines.		
FEES:	Individual events: \$10.00		
	Swimmer surcharge: \$2.50 per person (entered in the meet in any capacity)

SEEDING:	The Meet Director reserves the right to seed each session in up to 10 lanes for competition.  All events will be pre-gooded.		
AWARDS:	<ul> <li>All events will be pre-seeded.</li> <li>There will be no awards distributed at this meet.</li> </ul>		
PENALTIES:	A fine of up to \$100 per event may be assessed for any illegal participation in the meet. Illegal

	<ul> <li>Entries using fraudulent or non-verifiable times.</li> </ul>		
	Athletes competed in the incorrect age group.		
	Athletes are not registered with USA Swimming prior to the first day of the meet.  If the application and the control of the second of th		
	If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the		
	swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer.		
RULES:	<ul> <li>Any event in which an athlete participated illegally will be rescored and re-awarded.</li> <li>The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations including the Minor Athlete Abuse Protection</li> </ul>		
RULES.	<ul> <li>The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations including the Minor Athlete Abuse Protection Policy will govern this meet.</li> </ul>		
	<ul> <li>All adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the</li> </ul>		
	provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (MAAPP) and that they		
	understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this		
	competition.		
	Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA-S member coach as being		
	proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When		
	unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's		
	legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.		
	Operation of a drone or any other flying apparatus is prohibited over the venue (pools,		
	athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches,		
	officials, and/or spectators are present without written USA Swimming approval.		
	Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing		
	areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. In addition, photography behind the blocks is not permitted.		
	Changing, in whole or in part, into or out of a swimsuit when wearing just one suit in an area      that there is a lacker recent both some or other areas designated for the principal in PROLUBITED.		
	other than in a locker room, bathroom, or other space designated for changing is PROHIBITED.		
	<ul> <li>In accordance with VSI Best Practices, all athletes should shower before entering the pool.</li> <li>An athlete suspected of sustaining a concussion or exhibiting signs of a concussion will</li> </ul>		
	immediately be removed from competition and shall not return to competition that day. The		
	athlete may return to competition on a subsequent day, but only with a release authorization		
	signed by a licensed healthcare provider.		
	signed by a hooficed foundation provider.		

	<ul> <li>In accordance with VSI Policy, only those coaches who have current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches with expired or non-current credentials will be required to leave the deck area.</li> </ul>
