AWARDS:	No awards will be given.
RULES:	Swimmers/Spectator Conduct: Each club is responsible for supervising the conduct of its swimmers/spectators. Any swimmer/spectator who violates 757swim Aquatic Center rules (posted at the pool) will be disqualified from the meet and escorted from the facility.
	The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy, will govern this meet.
	All adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (MAAPP) and that they

	understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.
	<ul> <li>Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USAS member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) anytime athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present without written USA Swimming approval.</li> </ul>
	• Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. In addition, photography behind the blocks is <u>not permitted</u> .
	Changing, in whole or in part, into or out of swimsuit when wearing just one suit in an area other than in a locker room, bathroom, or other space designated for changing is PROHIBITED.
	In accordance with VSI best practices, all swimmers should shower before entering the pool.
	<ul> <li>Any athlete suspected of sustaining a concussion or exhibiting signs of a concussion, will immediately be removed from competition and shall not return to competition that day. The athlete may return to competition on a subsequent day, but only with a release authorization signed by a licensed healthcare provider.</li> </ul>
	In accordance with VSI Policy, only those coaches who have current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches with expired or non-current credentials will be required to leave the deck area.
PENALTIES:	<ul> <li>A fine of up to \$100 per event may be assessed for any illegal participation in the meet. Illegal participation is defined as</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Entries using fraudulent or non-verifiable times.</li> </ul>
	Athlete competed in the incorrect age group.
	<ul> <li>Athlete is not registered with USA Swimming prior to the first day of the meet.</li> </ul>
	• If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer.
	Any event in which an athlete participated illegally will be rescored and re-awarded.
