APPROVAL:	Held under Approval of USA Swimming/Virginia Swimming Approval # VS-26-012A. "In granting this approval it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming/Virginia Swimming, ISCA and Hampton Aquaplex shall be free and held harmless from any liabilities or claims from damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event."
CONDITION OF APPROVAL:	The meet host will ensure that the competition course meets the required dimensions as specified in 103.3 USA Swimming Rules and Regulations. Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA-S member coach, must be certified by a USA-S member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. Use of audio, visual, or cell phone recording devices is permitted only in designated Areas. Changing into or out of swimsuits, except in locker rooms, is strictly prohibited. Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the USA-S Vice President of Program Operations. All adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

TYPE OF MEET:	Short Course Yards, Prelims-Finals on Friday, and Saturday with Timed Finals on Sunday. One or two eight Lane course pools may be used for prelims and one eight lane pool for finals will be used. Teams will be notified of the number of courses by NLT Monday, November 10, 2025. There will be a 25-yard pool for constant warm up.

	Meet Director reserves the right to utilize two courses once entries are received. Teams will be notified no later than November 10, 2025, if two courses will be used.
TIMING SYSTEM:	A Colorado timing system, touch pads, backstroke wedges, and a digital scoreboard will be used as well as manual back up watches.
ELIGIBILITY:	Must be a 2025 USA Swimming, YMCA, AAU, and/or a World Aquatics registered athlete. No on-deck registration for Virginia Swimming/USA Swimming will be allowed. All USA Swimming 18 & over athletes must have completed the appropriate Athlete Protection Training (APT) prior to the first day of competition. Athletes whose 18th birthday occurs during competition must complete the APT prior to that date.
DISABILITY ATHLETES	 Age on November 14, 2025, will determine the age for the entire meet. Athletes with a disability are welcome and shall provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to the competition using the <u>Disability Accommodation Form.</u>

ATHLETES WITH A SERIOUS MEDICAL CONDITION:

- The swimmer (or the swimmer's coach) is responsible for notifying the Meet Referee, prior to the completion, of the medical condition that is potentially life-threatening while swimming and of any requested accommodations. Early notice (e.g, concurrent with the meet entry) is encouraged to allow for any needed planning or logistical support.
- This provision does not apply to medical conditions that are not life-threatening while swimming including injuries that limit range of motion.
- The Swimmer/coach shall provide a Personal Assistant(s) as needed.

FORMAT:

Please submit entry times in Short Course Yards - DO NOT SUBMIT CONVERTED TIMES. (Example: If the time was swum in short course yards, submit the short course time.) Non-conforming times will be seeded last according to USA Swimming Rules and Regulations 207.12.7B. All yard times will be seeded for prelims slowest to fastest within the two-age group order.

PLEASE NOTE THAT THERE ARE NO CHANGES OR TIME UPDATES PERMITTED AFTER THE PSYCH SHEET IS PUBLISHED.

The meet will be swum combined age-groups in preliminary sessions and split out 10-UNDER, 11-year-olds, 12-year-olds, 13 years old, 14 years old & SENIOR for finals. On Sunday there will be swum as Time Finals but awarded individual age group and Senior.

Relays

- 1. All mixed relays can be swum with any combination of 4 swimmers, but only the relays that have (2 Boys/2 Girls) will be scored. Relays will be swum as timed final events.
- 2. Each team may enter an "A" and "B" and "C" relay for each event.
- 3. Top 8 relays will swim in the finals session. Remaining relays will swim in the prelims session.

1650 Free (Timed Final Event):

1. 1650 will be swum alternating women/ men fastest to slowest at the end of Sunday's timed final session. We will only accept total 24 female and 24 male swimmers.

SENIOR & 13-14

400IM and 500 Free (Timed Final Event):

1. Top 8 seeded swimmers will swim in the final session. The remaining swimmers will swim in the prelims session. We will only accept 24 swimmers for both 400 IM and 500 Free.
