	• Indoor 8 lane 50 meter x 25 yard pool, has 9 ft. wide lanes with non-turbulent lane lines, a depth of 7'6" at the sides and 8'2"in the center.
	This Meet will be swum in the 50-Meter Course.
	Instructional Pool: Indoor 6 lane 25 yard pool for continuous warm-up/warm-down.
	Omega starting blocks, CTS6 with Dolphin wireless stopwatches and full color LED scoreboard will be used.
	There is Spectator Seating for 700 Plus.
	 The meet host will ensure that the competition course meets the required dimensions as specified in 103.3 USA Swimming Rules and Regulations. (USA-S Rule change.)
	The Collegiate School Aquatic Center will have a complete set of Lifeguards on Duty during the Meet. There is a large 1 st aid Station right off of the Main Deck. AED devises as well as Emergency Oxygen are available on site.
	• In order to provide parents/guardians who are outside of the facility the ability to view their athletes' events, this meet may be video streamed following all MAAPP guidelines. By attending or participating in this competition, you acknowledge and grant permission to be included in the video-streaming.

ELIGIBILITY:	Open to all USA Swimming athletes registered before the first day of the meet.
	No on-deck USA Swimming athlete registration will be permitted.
	2025-2028 NAG time standards are in effect.
	Age on June 21 st , 2025 will determine age for the entire meet.
DISABILITY SWIMMERS:	Athletes with a disability are welcome and shall provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director.
	The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to the competition using the <u>Disability Accommodation Form.</u>
ATHLETES WITH A SERIOUS MEDICAL CONDITION	 The Swimmer (or the Athlete's Coach) is responsible for notifying the Meet Referee prior to the competition of the medical condition that is potentially life-threatening while swimming and of any requested accommodations. Early notice (e.g. concurrent with the Meet entry) is encouraged to allow for any needed planning or logistical support. This provision does not apply to medical conditions that are not life-threatening while swimming including injuries that limit range. The Swimmer/Coach shall provide a Personal Assistant(s) as needed.

	Distance Sessions will start 15 Minutes after the end of the A.M. Sessions
	The Meet Director reserves the right to go to Chase Starts if need be to get the sessions under 4 hours. Teams will be notified NLT Sunday June 15, 2025, if chase starts will be used.
WARM-UP:	Morning Sessions: Warm-ups at 7:30 A.M. Competition starts at 8:30 A.M.
	Afternoon Sessions: Warm-ups at 12:30 P.M. Competition starts at 1:30 P.M.
	Distance sessions: The pool will be open for 10 minutes of open warm-ups immediately following the finish of the P.M. Session, with the distance session competition starting 5 minutes thereafter.
	The approximate start time for the distance sessions will be posted on at www.Swimwac.com website no later than Tuesday, June 17, 2025 and will also be emailed to the contact person of the participating clubs.
	 Lane assignment and warm-up times for individual clubs will be posted on the Swimwac.com website no later than Tuesday, June 17, 2025 and will also be emailed to the contact person of the participating clubs.
ENTRIES:	THE DEADLINE FOR THE RECEIPT OF ENTRIES IS Tuesday, June 10, 2025.
	Entries must be submitted in Long Course Meter times Commlink-2 software.
	Teams submit entries via email. Teams will be entered on first come, first served within the 4 hour time rule.
	 Coach Time (CT) entries will be accepted for events in which a swimmer does not have a time of record. <u>CT must be slower than an "A" time</u>. All entry times other than CT must have been achieved in USA Swimming sanctioned, approved, or observed competition. NT Entries will be accepted.
	Swimmers may enter a maximum of 4 individual events and 1 relay event per day.
	Entries will be processed in the order received and <u>accepted to</u> the greatest extent possible without exceeding the 4-hour/session timeline limit and in accordance with the regulations of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

	Deck entries will be accepted in the order received for swimmers already entered in the meet, to the extent that open lanes are available. No additional heats will be added. Deck entries must be submitted to the Administrative Official on the provided forms.

AWARDS:	Individual events: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 8th place.
	 13 & Over events will be given separate awards for 13-14 and 15 & over Age Groups.
	 12 & Under events will award separate awards for 11-12, 9-10 and 8 & under Age Groups.
SEEDING:	All events, except (#59 & 60 – 1650 Free) and (#115 & 116 – 800 Free) will be pre-seeded. The events listed here will be positive check-in events.
	Swimmers will report directly to the blocks for their events.
	Positive check-in will close at the end of warm-ups for the Afternoon Session in which the event is being swum. Check-in will be at the Table across from the computer room.
	SWIMMERS FAILING TO POSITIVELY CHECK-IN WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SWIM THE EVENT.
	All Positive Check-in events will be swum slowest to fastest in the normal # order.
PENALTIES:	A fine of up to \$100 per event may be assessed for any illegal participation in the meet. Illegal participation is defined as

	 Entries using fraudulent or non-verifiable times. Athletes competed in the incorrect age group. Athlete is not registered with USA Swimming prior to the first day of the meet.
	If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer.
	Any event in which an athlete participated illegally will be rescored and re-awarded.
RULES	The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy, will govern this meet.
	 All adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (MAAPP) and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.
	 Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) anytime athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present without written USA Swimming approval.
	 Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA-S member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
	Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. In addition, photography behind the blocks is not permitted.
	Changing, in whole or in part, into or out of swimsuit when wearing just one suit in an area other than in a locker room, bathroom, or other space designated for changing is PROHIBITED.
	In accordance with VSI best practices, all swimmers should shower before entering the pool.
	 Any athlete suspected of sustaining a concussion or exhibiting signs of a concussion will immediately be removed from competition and shall not return to competition that day. The athlete may return to competition on a subsequent day, but only with a release authorization signed by a licensed healthcare provider. In accordance with VSI Policy, only those coaches who have current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches with expired or non-current credentials will be required to leave the deck area.
