SWIMMERS:	•	The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to the competition using the <u>Disability Accommodation Form.</u>
ATHLETES WITH A SERIOUS MEDICAL	•	The swimmer (or the swimmer's coach) is responsible for notifying the Meet Referee, prior to the competition, of the medical condition that is potentially life-threatening while swimming and of any requested accommodations. Early notice (e.g., concurrent with the meet entry) is encouraged to allow for any needed planning or logistical support.
CONDITION:	•	This provision does not apply to medical conditions that are not life-threatening while swimming, including injuries that limit range of motion.
	•	The swimmer/coach shall provide a Personal Assistant(s) as needed.
FORMAT:	•	11-12 year old swimmers will swim prelim/finals in all individual events except the 400 IM and the 500 free which will be swum as timed finals. The top 16 swimmers in the 11-12 age group from prelims will come back to compete in finals, except for the 200 fly, 200 back, and 200 breast where only the top 8 swimmers will compete in finals.
	•	9 -10-year-old swimmers will swim prelim/finals in all individual events with the exception of the 200 IM and 500 Free which will be contested as timed finals. The top 8 swimmers in the 9/10 age group from prelims will come back to compete in finals. The fastest heat of the 200 IM will be swum in finals.
	•	Ready Room: A Ready Room will be used at this Championship prior to each "A" final heat. Each Swimmer in the "A" Final (Final heat) should report to the Ready Room 10 minutes preceding the event and participate in the "A" Final parade.

	•	"B" Final heats will report directly to their assigned lane.
	•	All heats of the 11–12-year-old 400 Free Relay will be swum during the Friday prelims session. All heats of the 11-12 and 9-10 year old 200 Free (Saturday) and 200 Medley Relays (Sunday) will be swum during the Finals sessions.
	•	There will be a 5 minute break at the conclusion of relays swum in Finals before the start of individual events on Saturday and Sunday.
ENTRIES:	DE	ADLINE FOR THE RECEIPT OF ENTRIES IS TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 4, 2025
	•	Entries must be submitted in Short Course Yards times using Commlink-2 software.
	•	Teams submit entries via e-mail.
	•	A printout of entries must be included with the name, email address, and phone number of the person to contact in case of questions must accompany the entries, regardless of how they are submitted.
	•	"No Time" (NT) entries will be accepted for individual and relay events. Coach Times (CT) are <u>not</u> <u>allowed</u> for any event. All entry times must have been achieved in a sanctioned, approved, or observed meet.
	•	If a relay seed time cannot be created using the times of 4 swimmers entered in the meet, enter the relay with a NT.
	•	Swimmers may enter a maximum of 8 individual events for the meet, no more than 3 per day and 1 relay event per day.
	•	Relay teams must be designated A, B, C, etc., if more than one per club is entered per event. Relay entry times must be slower than the combined "AG Championship" times for the corresponding relay. See the "slower than" relay times chart on page 5.
	•	The Meet Director reserves the right to combine heats and events, which may require reseeding.

	•	Late entries will be accepted. If received prior to the printing of the heat sheet, the swimmer will be seeded into the event; if after, he/she will go in the slowest heat in an empty lane. If needed, a heat will be added.

If the morning session runs late, afternoon warm-ups will begin immediately after the morning session ends.  SEEDING:  All swimmers should report directly to the blocks for all preliminary and "B" Final events.  Positive check-in for the 9-10 500 Free, 11-12 500 Free, and 11-12 400 IM, will be pre-seeded.  All swimmers should report directly to the blocks for all preliminary and "B" Final events.  Positive check-in for the 9-10 500 free, 11-12 500 Free and 11-12 400 IM will close 20 minutes to the end of warm-ups for the session in which the events will be swum. Positive check-in rost will be located at the Administrative Official's desk.  SWIMMERS FAILING TO POSITIVELY CHECK-IN WILL NOT BE SEEDED.  Aswimmer who positively checks-in for a distance event and does not show up to comp will not be able to swim his/her next event. Any event in which an athlete participated illegally will be rescored and re-awarded.	

## RULES: The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Protection Policy, will govern this meet. All adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (MAAPP) and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USAS member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) anytime athletes, coaches. officials and/or spectators are present without written USA Swimming approval. Any swimmer initially announced as qualifying for an event in finals who fails scratch from the event and fails to compete in the event at finals will be barred from competing in any additional events in that session. Additionally, the athlete will be barred from competing in his/her next individual event in a subsequent session. Alternates will be announced along with final qualifiers but shall not be penalized if unavailable to compete in the finals. Rule 207.11.6.E 1-3, Exceptions for Failure to Compete, will be followed. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. In addition, photography behind the blocks is not permitted. Changing, in whole or in part, into or out of swimsuit when wearing just one suit in an area other than in a locker room, bathroom, or other space designated for changing is PROHIBITED. In accordance with VSI best practices, all athletes should shower before entering the pool. Any athlete suspected of sustaining a concussion or exhibiting signs of a concussion, will immediately be removed from competition and shall not return to competition that day. The athlete may return to competition on a subsequent day, but only with a release authorization signed by a licensed healthcare provider. In accordance with VSI Policy, only those coaches who have current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches with expired or non-current credentials will be required to leave the deck area. ### TIMERS: • Swimmers supply their own timers and lap counters for the 500 Freestyle

- Clubs may be required to provide timers in proportion to the number of swimmers they have entered in each session.
- The number of timers required per club and their lane assignments will be posted on the CGBD website no later than Monday, Feb. 10, 2025 and will also be emailed to the contact person of each of the individual clubs.
- These assignments will also be posted throughout the venue.

## **GENERAL:** Swimmer/Spectator Conduct: Each club is responsible for supervising the conduct of its swimmers/spectators. Any swimmer/spectator who violates Community/Aquatic Center rules (posted at the pool) will be disqualified from the meet and/or escorted from the facility. No glass, food, chewing gum, or open drinks allowed in the pool area. Drinks in closed containers (e.g. sports bottles with screw-on tops, plastic bottles with screw-on tops) are acceptable. No shaving anywhere in the venue. No running or horseplay in the facility. Shoes/sandals must be worn by all in/around the recreation center, except for the pool area. The Aquatic Center will be closed during electrical storms. 0 NO SMOKING in the Aquatic Center (pool area) or the rest of the building. Deck Access: Access to the pool deck is strictly controlled prior to the first warm-up session. Coaches, swimmers and spectators will be allowed on the pool deck no earlier than 15 minutes prior to the first warmup session, and not until two Marshals and the Announcer are in place. Seating for coaches/swimmers will be in the bleachers on the long side of the pool and spectators will be in the bleachers on the short side of the pool with additional seating available in the gym. No outside chairs allowed inside Aquatic Center; however, they are allowed in the gym. Everyone must stay behind the ropes on each side of the pool. SWIM BAGS WILL NOT be allowed on the pool deck. The City of Newport News prohibits eating food inside Aquatic Center; therefore, coolers must be left in the gym or vehicles. The City of Newport News requires everyone leaving the pool area and entering any other part of the facility to wear shoes or sandals. Team Banners: Not allowed for this meet. Heat Sheets: Heat Sheets will be made available to everyone on the Meet Mobile app and will be posted on the CGBD website in a pdf format that can be viewed or printed. Results: The meet results will be available on Meet Mobile, posted to the CGBD website and will be posted to the Virginia Swimming website after the conclusion of the meet. **Snack Bar**: A concession stand WILL be operated during the meet. Swim Supplies: Aquawear will operate a Swim Shop during the meet. First Aid: There is a First Aid room on the pool deck and will be staffed by facility lifequards. If assistance is needed anywhere off of the pool deck, see a Meet Marshall or Facility Staff Member. Lost and Found: Lost and found will be located next to the announcer's table. Hospitality: CGBD will operate a Hospitality Room for all coaches and officials during the meet. Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner and light snacks will be provided. Bottled water will be available for coaches, officials and volunteers on the pool deck in a cooler near the administrative table. Only Coaches. Officials, and meet staff are allowed in the Hospitality Room. **PARKING:** Park only in designated (marked) parking spots. Parents must park in the main lots. The Staff parking lot on the pool side of the building is off limits. Overflow parking is available at Hines Middle School (next door) **DIRECTIONS:** From the north/south, follow I-64 to Exit 258 A. J Clyde Morris Boulevard, Take J. Clyde Morris Boulevard to Jefferson Avenue. Turn Left and go approximately 2.5 miles to McLawhorne Drive. Turn right at the light. Pool is on the left.
