	The Top 1 heat (9) of single age 11-year-old and Top 1 heat (9) of 12-year-old swimmers will swim the final session each day.			
	The Top 1 heat (9) of 10&under will swim in the final session each day.			
	• The top two heats (18) in the 13-14 and Top three heats (27) of Senior age groups will swim the final session each day except Senior Events #19 & 20 (400 IM) and where the top two heats (18), will swim in finals.			

The following events will be swum as timed finals with the top Heat (9) after seeding of each age group swimming in finals: 11-12 (#43 & 44) 200 Back, (#77 & 78) 200 Fly, (#105 and 106) 200 Breast. CT's must be slower than an A time. All entry times other than CT must have been achieved in USA Swimming sanctioned, approved, or observed competition. Swimmers may enter 3 individual events per day. Relay teams must be designated A, B, C, etc., if more than one per club is entered per event. Entries will be processed in the order received and accepted to the greatest extent possible without exceeding the 4-hour/session timeline limit or the limits as mandated by current Commonwealth of Virginia guidelines. No heats will be added. Ribbons 4th-10th place. 13 & Over events will be given separate awards for 13-14 and Senior age groups. 11/12 events will be scored as single age groups, 11 yr olds and 12 yr olds. 10& Under events will be scored as one age group. Relay events: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 10th place.

A fine of up to \$100 per event may be assessed for any illegal participation in the meet. Illegal participation is defined as Entries using fraudulent or non-verifiable times. Athletes competed in the incorrect age group. Athlete is not registered with USA Swimming prior to the first day of the meet. If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer.
	Any event in which an athlete participated illegally will be rescored and re-awarded.
RULES:	 The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Protection Policy, will govern this meet. All adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of the participation in the conduct of this competition.
	 Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USAS member coach as being proficient in performing a racing dive or must start each race from within the water. If unaccompanied by a member coach, the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian must ensure compliance with this requirement.
	• The scratch procedures listed in the current <i>USA Swimming Rules and Regulations</i> , Article 207.12.6, sections D and E only will be in effect and modified as follows: The scratch rule regarding finals will apply to all heats (final, consolation, and bonus, as appropriate).
	 Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. In addition, photography behind the blocks is not permitted.
	 Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present without written USA Swimming approval.
	Changing, in whole or in part, into or out of a swimsuit when wearing just one suit in an area other than in a locker room, bathroom, or other space designated for changing is PROHIBITED.
	In accordance with VSI best practices, all swimmers should shower before entering the pool.
	 An athlete suspected of sustaining a concussion or exhibiting signs of a concussion, will immediately be removed from competition and shall not return to competition that day. The athlete may return to competition on a subsequent day, but only with a release authorization signed by a licensed healthcare provider
	 In accordance with VSI Policy, only those coaches who have current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches with expired or non-current credentials will be required to leave the deck area.
