SEEDING:	Swimmers should report directly to the blocks for their events.				
	All events will be pre-seeded.				
	Distance events 400 IM (Events 25, 26), 500 Free (Events 49, 50), and 1000 Free (Events 51, 52) and will require positive check-in. Check-in will close 30 minutes prior to the start of the session. At the discretion of the meet referee, the events will be reseeded if sufficient scratches are received.				
WARM-UP:	Morning sessions: Warm-ups not before 7:00 am; competition starts at 8:00 am.				
	 Lane assignment and warm-up times for individual clubs will be posted on the ECAT website NLT Monday, October 21st and will also be emailed to the contact person of the participating clubs. 				
AWARDS:	Individual events: Ribbons will be awarded for first through first through eighth place.				
	13 & Over events will be given separate awards for 13-14 and 15 & Over age groups.				

12 & Younger events will be given separate awards for 11-12, 9-10, and 8 and Under age groups. **RULES:** The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy will govern this meet. All adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (MAAPP) and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA-S member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present without written USA Swimming approval. • Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. In addition, photography behind the blocks is not permitted. • Changing, in whole or in part, into or out of swimsuit when wearing just one suit in an area other than in a locker room, bathroom, or other space designated for changing is PROHIBITED. In according with Virginia Swimming Best Practices, all athletes should shower before entering the pool. An athlete suspected of sustaining a concussion or exhibiting signs of a concussion will immediately be removed from competition and shall not return to competition that day. The athlete may return to competition on a subsequent day, but only with a release authorization signed by a licensed healthcare provider. In accordance with Virginia Swimming Policy, only those coaches who have current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches with expired or non-current credentials will be required to leave the deck area. **PENALTIES:** A fine of up to \$100 per event may be assessed for any illegal participation in the meet. Illegal participation is defined as Entries using fraudulent or non-verifiable times. Athlete competed in the incorrect age group. o Athlete is not registered with USA Swimming prior to the first day of the meet. If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. 	 Athletes are responsible for providing their own timer and counter for distance events.

	Snack food: A concession stand will be available during the meet.				
	 Hospitality: ECAT will provide a Hospitality Room for coaches, officials and officials in training. Breakfast and lunch will be served. Snacks will be provided during the day.
