	• Distance events 1000 Free (Events 45, 46), 500 Free (Events 43, 44), and 400 IM (Events 53, 54) will require positive check-in. Check-in will close 30 minutes prior to the start of the session. At the discretion of the meet referee, the events will be reseeded if sufficient scratches are received.

RULES:	The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations including the Minor Athlete Abuse Protection Policy will govern this meet.				
	All adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse				

Prevention Policy (MAAPP) and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

- Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA-S member coach
 as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from
 within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the
 responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure
 compliance with this requirement.
- Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present without written USA Swimming approval.
- Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. In addition, photography behind the blocks is not permitted.
- Changing, in whole or in part, into or out of swimsuit when wearing just one suit in an area other than in a locker room, bathroom, or other space designated for changing is PROHIBITED.
- In according with Virginia Swimming Best Practices, all athletes should shower before entering the pool.
- An athlete suspected of sustaining a concussion or exhibiting signs of a
 concussion will immediately be removed from competition and shall not return to
 competition that day. The athlete may return to competition on a subsequent
 day, but only with a release authorization signed by a licensed healthcare
 provider.
- In accordance with Virginia Swimming Policy, only those coaches who have current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches with expired or non-current credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

PENALTIES:

- A fine of up to \$100 per event may be assessed for any illegal participation in the meet. Illegal participation is defined as
 - Entries using fraudulent or non-verifiable times.
 - o Athlete competed in the incorrect age group.
 - Athlete is not registered with USA Swimming prior to the first day of the meet.
- If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer.

 Any event in which an athlete participated illegally will be rescored and re-awarded.

FACILITY RULES:	Swimmer/Spectator Conduct: Each club is responsible for supervising the conduct of its swimmers/spectators. Any swimmer/spectator that violates Aquatic Center rules, posted at the pool and in the meet program will be disqualified from the meet and escorted from the facility.

	 Deck Access: There are spectator seating on the pool deck. Only Swimmers, meet volunteers, and Staff are allowed to walk the sides and behind the block. The Sides of the pool and start end will be strictly enforced. 					
	 Parking: Parking will be available in the parking lot of the Boys and Girls Club and additional parking at the Crossroads church next door. 					
	 Swimmer bags and equipment are only allowed on the deck and are not permitted to be left in the athletic locker-rooms.

	No glass, food, or chewing gum will be permitted on the pool deck.
