# **Pre-Competition**

Late Entries: Any team or athlete missing the entry deadline will be permitted to enter late, subject to the following requirements:

- o Late entries must be submitted to Scott Baldwin, edbaldwi@vt.edu
- o Entries must be received no later than 12:00 pm (EST) Tuesday, March 19, 2024.
- o The team or athlete must pay a one-time processing fee of \$150 and entry fees of \$32 per individual event.
- o Late entries may not be used to improve the seed time of an earlier entry.

## **Competition**

#### Timelines:

All prelim start times are 8:45 am Friday, Saturday and Sunday

Estimated Pre-Scratch Prelim End Times: Thursday – 4:16 pm (Start time is 3:30 pm)

Friday – 11:40 am

Saturday - 12:26 pm

Sunday - 11:35 am

Finals start times are 5:30pm on Friday and Saturday and 4:30pm on Sunday

Sunday distance approximate start time 3:00 pm with a 3:30pm finish.



## **Competition**

Prelims: Fly-over starts
Distance Freestyle:

- Each athlete provide their own timer and counter (if desired)
- Athletes will be seeded in events if not SCRATCHED.
- Thursday distance will be swum Fastest to Slowest with any Time Trial distance swimmers added to the end and included in the last not complete heat.
- May request afternoon swim on SUNDAY (at Admin Resolution Desk please write PRELIM). Will be swum Slowest to Fastest.
- Fastest heat per gender that did not request a prelim swim will compete at finals on SUNDAY. Remaining heats will be scheduled so that the last heat will finish just prior to warm-ups for finals.

#### Competition

#### Scratches:

- · Scratches for Thursday distance events are due by 5pm Wednesday, March 20.
- Prelims Scratches for Friday prelims including relays are due by 4:00 pm on Thursday. Scratches for all subsequent days, including relays, are due by 6:00pm.
- Scratches for Thursday and Friday can be emailed/texted to the admim referee once prelims start on Friday, all scratches must be done in person only
- No Show during prelims
  - Barred from further individual and relay events AND TIME TRIALS for the day (no buy back in)
  - Must positively check-in with admin ref before evening scratch deadline to be seeded for subsequent days
- · May DFS at administrative table or with chief judge at starting area
  - No penalty
  - · Counts toward 3 event max for the day (with time trials)

#### Competition

#### Scratches cont:

- · From Finals At administrative table
  - · 30 min after event is read (will also try and scroll results)
  - Intent to Scratch
  - No show during finals follows National Scratch Rules removed from meet if initially qualified for finals.
  - Be sure to scratch your swimmer from finals, REGARDLESS OF PLACEMENT, if they will not be returning/swimming in finals so that we can minimize chances of empty lanes in finals if we have large numbers of scratches, especially on Sunday

#### Swim Offs

- Please listen for results or check scrolling. We will be swimming off/resolving places 8/9, 16/17, 24/25/26
- · Come to admin table if you think athlete may be in a swim- off
- Must be contested/resolved BEFORE the end of prelims within 45 min after the last INDIVIDUAL event
- Do not leave the pool athlete or coach unless you are certain that there is no possibility that you are in a tie that must be resolved.

## **Competition**

- · Finals Order is C, B, A
- C is limited to 18 & Under athletes
- "A" Finalists Paraded
- "A" Finalists report to ready room 5 minutes before parade time includes top heat of distance
- All other finalist report straight to the blocks
- No Show in Friday and Saturday Finals will be barred from the remainder of the meet (no buy in)
- No Show in Sunday Finals will incur \$50 fine



### Competition

Awards will be given immediately following the conclusion of the "A" final to the top 3 finishers.

- Chief judges will direct the top 3 finishers to the podium.
- The coach of winning athlete will present awards. Be there quickly so athletes may warm down
- Will start as soon as all athletes are present

## **Competition**

#### Time Trials (limited to no more than 1 hour)

- · Sign-up location in the Fun Pool area
- Thursday:
  - · Begin 15 minutes after the timed finals
  - · Distance Only to be included in slowest heats if possible
  - · Contact Scott Baldwin directly to sign-up
  - · Sign-up closes at 3:30 pm
- · Friday, Saturday and Sunday
  - · Begin not before 15 min after conclusion of prelims
  - Sign-up Begins each morning at 7am; Closes at 10:00 am or when the time limit has been reached, whichever is earlier

Maximum of three (3) during the meet and are included in the limitation of three (3) events per day.


