- 25 yard six lane indoor pool with water depth 4 to 6 feet and starting blocks at the deep end. Colorado Timing system and 3-line scoreboard. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with current *USA Swimming Rules and Regulations*, Article 104.2.2C (4).
- Carter Athletic Center shall be held free and harmless from any and all liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of this event.
- In order to provide parents/guardians who are outside of the facility the ability to view their athletes' events, this meet may be video streamed following all MAAPP guidelines. ELIGIBILITY:

- Open to all athletes on CCA Marlins who are registered with USA Swimming before the first day of the meet. Depending upon the number of entries received, additional teams may be allowed.
 Please contact the meet director if interested in attending.
- Age on November 19, 2022 will determine age for the entire meet.

DISABILITY SWIMMERS:

- Athletes with a disability are welcome and shall provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director.
- The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to the competition.

FORMAT:

- All swimmers 12&Under and 13&Over will swim in Sunday 11/19 AM session
- All swimmers 12&Under and 13&Over will swim in Sunday 11/20 AM session.
- All events will be pre-seeded and timed finals, swimming slowest to fastest.
- Swimmers 13 and Older will be allowed to swim a 50 easy right after their events for recovery then will exit the pool.
- All swimmers will report behind the blocks, with two heats at a time,
- 9 & Overs will participate in an IMR or IMX meet format. Each swimmer age 9 & Over enters the
 entire event lineup for the meet either the IMR slate of events or the IMX slate of events, based
 on his/her age. IMX scores will be calculated and the highest scoring age swimmer in each age
 group, male and female, will be crowned the "Challenge" winner.

ENTRIES:	DEADLINE FOR THE RECEIPT OF ENTRIES IS Tuesday November 8, 2022			
	 Each swimmer must enter the entire event lineup for the meet or session, either the IMR slate of events or the IMX slate of events, or the IM mini slate of events. Entries will be processed in the order received and accepted to the greatest extent possible without exceeding the 4-hour/session timeline limit or the limits as mandated by current commonwealth of Virginia guidelines. 			
	 After the entry deadline, breaks may be added during sessions and clubs will be notified when receiving their lane assignments and warm-up times as referenced above under warm-ups. SEEDING:	All events will be pre-seeded.			
WARM-UP:	 Sunday 11/21 morning Open session's warmups start not before 7:00am, meet starts not before 8:00am Sunday 11/21 morning Open session's warmups start not before 7:00am, meet starts not before 8:00am 			
AWARDS:	 IM Extreme Champion awards will be given for top male and female IMX point scorer in each age group: 9-10/11-12/13-14/15 & Over IM Mini Champion awards will be given for the top male 8 & Under and top female 8 & Under 			
PENALTIES:	 A fine of up to \$100 per event may be assessed for any illegal participation in the meet. Illegal participation is defined as Entries using fraudulent or non-verifiable times. Athlete competed in the incorrect age group. Athlete is not registered with USA Swimming prior to the first day of the meet. If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer. Any event in which an athlete participated illegally will be rescored and re-awarded. 			
RULES:	 The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations including the Minor Athlete Abuse Protection Policy will govern this meet. All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are 			
	subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (MAAPP)			

	and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.
	Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA-S member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
	 Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present without written USA Swimming approval.
	 Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. In addition, photography behind the blocks is <u>not permitted</u>.
	Changing, in whole or in part, into or out of swimsuit when wearing just one suit in an area other than in a locker room, bathroom, or other space designated for changing is PROHIBITED.
	 An athlete suspected of sustaining a concussion or exhibiting signs of a concussion, will immediately be removed from competition and shall not return to competition that day. The athlete may return to competition on a subsequent day, but only with a release authorization signed by a licensed healthcare provider.
	 In accordance with VSI Policy, only those coaches who have current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches with expired or non-current credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

TIMERS:	 Timers assignment will be sent to the participating teams Timers should report to assigned lanes 10 min before the start of each session. There will be 2 timers per lane. 500 free swimmers need to provide their own counters and timers. Timers and counters must wear a mask
GENERAL:	There will be a light refreshment and dinner available on Friday PM session for coaches and officials, light breakfast and Lunch for the Saturday sessions.
	Heat sheets will be sent digitally, there will be no paper copies available during the meet.
