Rules and Legislation Updates:

Report attached

- Updated bylaws have been posted on the website.
- **Updating language in VSI meet announcements for swimmers with disabilities** – recommend using new language regarding accommodations/modifications and parallel time standards for disability athletes. The Age Group Committee will discuss at their next meeting.

Policy Changes- Provisional Status (Must be approved by HOD)

- **Removing Officials Discipline and De-Certification Guidelines**
- Derek Paul (General Counsel of USA Swimming) says this section needs to be removed from the policies.
- **Parallel Time Standards for Swimmers with Disabilities** – see above
- **Officials Travel Reimbursement**
 - Came up because of the World Cup meet.
 - Allows language for officials to get a 3rd reimbursement if the reimbursement is for a “By Invitation Only” meet (i.e. Olympic Trials and World Cup)

Procedure Changes – 46.6 Championship Meet Entry Guidelines

- Allowing athletes to be added to an event at Senior Champs and Age Group champs while on deck. Age Group and Senior Committee will need to evaluate.
- **Other Fees** (Section 46.6) – changing the procedure from printing to publishing in the language of Procedure Section 46.6. Updated language in quotes below.
 - “Swimmers added prior to the publishing of the heat sheet will be seeded as stated in the invitation. Swimmers added after the publishing of the heat sheet will be seeded in the slowest heat in the appropriate empty lane.”
 - **Motion:** The motion to approve this change passed.

Posting Hy-Tek Files Online:

- The BOD made a decision in April to remove the Hytek files from the website. It has caused some fury in our LSC and across the country. Some LSCs have put the data back on the websites without the birthdates. USA Swimming said it is allowable as long as the PII information is removed.
- Mary checked with 15+ LSCs and about half who have it posted including one LSC who put the information back up. She also contacted UVA, VA Tech, Liberty and W&M. These schools use SwimCloud with one having a subscription. They in general are not interested in LSC level meets. One school uses it for recruiting.

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- Two people have sent emails to the LSC asking about results being posted. Drew offered that NOVA has had several people contact the team directly. He would like to see the burden off of our clubs.
- SwimCloud allows parents to upload times individually and these times are identified differently.
- Jonathan says we should put the information back up without the personal information of the athletes.
- **Motion:** Post the meet results from the 2025-2026 season in the Hytek file without the personal information. The motion passed unanimously.

LSC Services Committee: need to schedule a meeting. Bryan will send out an email poll to determine the date.

Senior Champs Decisions to be made

- **Spirit Nights at Senior Champs:** Athletes are working on spirit nights for Senior Champs.
- **Confirm Order of Events** – see below

This would also be the order of events for 13 & O District Champs pending information from the Age Group Committee.

- **Decide on time qualification for 50s of stroke (time standards?)**
 - Maximum number of events is eight for both SC and LC.
 - Choices for time qualification are time standards, bonus events or use the 100 QT to enter in the 50 of that stroke are the options.
 - **Motion:** Use the 100 QT to get the 50 for that stroke through SC Senior Champs of 2027. This motion was approved.
 - 200 Medley Relays change over once there are time standards created. They will enter the meet with the 100 time. This practice will continue SC of 2027.
 - Current plan: Create QTs for 50s of Stroke and 200 Medley Relay times of entry will begin at SC 2027.
 - Age Group is waiting for two full seasons before creating time standards. SC 2027 would be the first meet with time standards for all Senior Champs events.
- **Confirm qualifying period**- the qualifying period for SC Senior Champs will start November 1, 2024.
- **Confirm adjusting to daylight saving time**
 - Session start times on Sunday will be no less than thirty minutes but up to one hour forward at SC Senior Champs. Mary will confirm the timeline from 2025 and notify the committee.
- **Confirm status of AM v PM designation for relays and 2 fastest heats of finals**

- Jonathan suggested AM v PM designation on Sunday only. A final decision needs to be made.

There will be an email vote two fastest (or not) for the following options:

Option 1

Only the Top 16 relays (200 free and 200 medley) would compete in finals. Any additional relays (17th seed & above) would compete in the prelims session.

Option 2

All 200 free and 200 medley relays competing at finals, leaving no 200 relays to compete in prelims.

Vote: The final vote was 8-4 in favor of Option 2. Top 16 will be used for all relays at Senior Champs.

- Confirm parading of A final**
 - The committee agreed to parade in the A final.
- Confirm meet deadline per request of coaches to have one deadline instead of two.**
 - TBD – the meet host and admin will need to weigh in.

VSI Finance Meeting was held via zoom on 11/2/2025 @ 1600

Meeting was recorded per Mary Turner.

Introduction of Team members in attendance: Will Murphy, Mary Turner, Bob Rustin, Bill Geiszler, Richard Hill, Michael Sizemore, Jenna Stevens(athlete), Preston Broderick(athlete).

Review of the VSI Finance Budget Process, policies and procedures, and revenues for the fiscal year. Identified that 40% of the revenue is generated by swimmer registration and meet rebate fees. Explained that the main factor in revenue is the number of swimmers in the Virginia LSC each year. This year we projected 7,000 athletes for the budget. This is a decrease from the previous year of 7,100 swimmers.

Review of past year events: Scholarships awarded, Outreach funding and Learn to Swim grants.

Discussed the 2 separate balances in the endowment funds and that the endowments are able to support a withdrawal of \$12,000/year from each account without affecting the principal.

Bob Rustin gave an update from the treasures desk.

Bill Geiszler updated the team on Outreach funding, which has consistently increased year over year.

New discussion on the ORCA events in Florida sponsored by ISCA for April 2026. Finance team felt that more information was needed prior to supporting the event.

Plan for Spring budget meeting on 03/22/2026 @ 1300-1500 via zoom.

VSI Rules and Legislation Coordinator Report

October 31, 2025 (amended November 7, 2025)

As a follow up to the legislation passed at the September 27, 2025, USA Swimming HOD meeting, the Virginia Swimming Bylaws were updated to incorporate required changes that affected the duties of the Governance Committee. The changes were approved by USA Swimming on September 30, 2025.

The following is a compendium of proposals that range from Meet Announcement language changes to suggested procedure and policy changes. Some of this requires further discussion and some of this is ready for action.

UPDATE THE LANGUAGE USED IN THE “DISABILITY SWIMMERS” SECTION OF VSI MEET ANNOUNCEMENTS

Background: Rule 105.1.2A states the following: “The swimmer (or the swimmer's coach) is responsible for notifying the Referee, prior to the competition, of any swimmer with a disability and of the requested accommodations and/or modifications. The swimmer/coach shall provide a Personal Assistant(s) or any equipment (tappers, deck mats, etc.) if required.”

The language in VSI meet announcements currently mentions only accommodations and not modifications, and the language has notice going to the Meet Director and not to the Meet Referee.

Proposal: First, update the section header to “Athletes with Disabilities.” Second, adopt the language developed by the National DEI Disability Subcommittee. Two versions are suggested with the second version calling out the use of the parallel time standards when in use. Note that the linked “Athlete Accommodation/Modification Form” is currently linked in our Meet Announcements.

Language for meets with no time standards

- Coaches entering swimmers with disabilities that require any accommodations or modifications, including the need for personal assistants and/or registered service animals, must provide advance notice in writing, accompanying their meet entry file, to the meet referee by the entry deadline. Failure to provide advance notice may limit the host’s ability to accommodate all requests.

Language for meets with qualifying time standards

- All swimmers with a disability must meet the Parallel Time Standards according to their performance group (P1, P2, P3) in every event they wish to participate in the meet. Coaches entering swimmers with disabilities that require any accommodations or modifications, including the need for personal assistants and/or registered service animals, must provide advance notice in writing, accompanying their meet entry file, to the meet referee by the entry deadline. Failure to provide advance notice may limit the host’s ability to accommodate all requests.

POLICY AMENDMENT PROPOSAL (OFFICIALS: GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR DISCIPLINE AND DE-CERTIFICATION)

Purpose: In approximately 2002, the USA Swimming National Officials Committee developed a document covering “Officials: General Guidelines for Discipline and De-Certification.” LSCs were encouraged/mandated to incorporate the guidelines into their operating policy. Virginia Swimming did so by incorporating the guidelines as a policy in the Virginia Swimming Policy and Procedures manual.

Based on comments made in the context of a recent LSC Officials Chairs meeting, Kevin Hogan followed up with Dana Covington (chair, National Officials Committee) and Derek Paul (associate general counsel, USA Swimming) as to the current applicability of the guidelines. Per Derek, there are sections of the guidelines that are no longer effective (eg, an LSC can no longer de-certify an official) and indicated that the language should be removed.

This proposal removes the guidelines in their entirety from the Virginia Swimming policies so that we are compliant with current practice.

The section would be intentionally left blank to avoid renumbering procedure sections 34-57.

POLICY AMENDMENT PROPOSAL (USE OF PARALLEL TIME STANDARDS FOR SWIMMERS WITH DISABILITIES)

Purpose: To encourage the participation of swimmers with disabilities in Virginia Swimming meets, any meet that uses minimal or maximal time standards, must also use the USA Swimming Parallel Time Standards for swimmers with disabilities.

Proposal:

17.3 When time standards are used to determine eligibility of a swimmer to enter an event in a meet, the ability of swimmers with a disability must be determined by using the USA Swimming Parallel Time Standards according to the swimmer's performance group (P1, P2, P3) in every event in which they wish to participate in the meet.

POLICY AMENDMENT PROPOSAL (OFFICIALS' TRAVEL REIMBURSEMENT POLICY)

Purpose: (1) Eliminate “lower” level meets from reimbursement consideration as there are now a sufficient number of Officials Qualifying Meets within Virginia Swimming that N2 and N3 certification evaluations can be met within the LSC. (2) Clarify that international meets, when held within the US, are reimbursable meets; (3) Allow for the reimbursement of a third meet if the third meet is a “by invitation only” meet. These meets would include Olympic Trials (for which policy already allows a third reimbursement for swimmers and coaches and for which current practice is to reimburse officials), the World Cup, and PanPacs. It should be noted that those officials receiving an invitation to officiate at “by invitation only” meets are officiating at a minimum of two, and often three or four, national level meets per year and are incurring substantial out-of-pocket expenses even when reimbursed for some of them. (4) Clarify that attendance at a National Championship Disability meet is required for reimbursement in that category.

Proposal:

29.2 The following meets qualify for reimbursement: ~~Eastern Zone Championships, Speedo Champions Series (Sectional Championships),~~ Futures, TYR Pro Series, US Open, ~~World Cup,~~ and USA Swimming National and Junior National Championships; trials class meets including Olympic Trials and World Championship Trials; and international competition held domestically including, but not limited to, the World Cup and PanPacs~~championship level meets identified in USA Swimming Rules and Regulations.~~ Meets held within the VSI boundaries do not qualify for reimbursement.

29.4 VSI will reimburse an official for travel expenses no more than two times (three times if the third meet is Olympic Trials or another “by invitation only” meet) per fiscal year (1 September – 31 August) for any of the meets listed in ~~paragraph 2~~section 29.2 above. In addition, officials ~~will~~can be reimbursed for attending one National Championship Disability Meet per fiscal year.

PROCEDURE CHANGE CONCEPT

Background: Championship meet entry deadlines are specified in VSI Policies and Procedures. VSI procedures currently state the following in procedures section 46.6.A “Other Fees.”

Championship meet entries received after the entry deadline will be accepted at a cost of \$10.00/event up until the first day before the start of the meet. Beginning the first day of the meet, the charge will be \$25.00/event. These fees will be in addition to regular meet entry fees. Swimmers added prior to the printing of the heat sheet will be seeded as stated in the invitation. Swimmers added after the printing of the heat sheet will be seeded in the slowest heat in the appropriate empty lane. A new heat(s) will be added if necessary to accommodate these entries. The host team will retain fees received for these late entries.

I recommend changing this procedure for two reasons.

First, I think the standard set for late entries in this section is unreasonable. While adding a swimmer to an empty lane in an already seeded event is not a big deal, creating a new heat and reseeding two swimmers after the heat sheets have been printed and distributed is a big deal. While it may have never happened, section 46.6.A essentially allows for entries up until the start of an event. The section allows a coach to enter a swimmer into an event part way through a session and in doing so create a need to add a heat and reseed two swimmers into that heat.

Second, the procedure sets expectations that are not consistent with late entry practice at higher level meets. National and sectional meets all appear to set a deadline of noon two days prior to the start day of the meet.

Recommendations: First, I think it would be helpful to clarify that “other fees” applies to VSI Age Championship meets and VSI Senior Championship meets, but not to other championship meets.

My second recommendation is that we make the late entry deadline for AGC and SC be at noon two days prior to the start of the meet. If that recommendation does not have support, I then recommend the following:

- For Age Group Champs, for pre-seeded events on the first day of the meet, the entry deadline shall be 6:00 pm the day before the meet starts. For all other pre-seeded events, the entry deadline shall be 30 minutes after the start of finals the day preceding the event. For all positive check-in events, the entry deadline shall be at the close of positive check-in.
- For Senior Champs, the entry deadline shall be by the close of the scratch box or the close of positive check-in for the event being entered.

Discussion and consensus by the BOD is needed to determine if and how this proposal should go forward.
