WARM-UP:	Open warm-up not before 8:00 am; Competition starts not before 9:00 am.

	"No Time" (NT) entries will be accepted for events in which a swimmer does not have a time of				
	record. All entry times must have been achieved in USA Swimming sanctioned, approved, or observed competition.				
	Swimmers may enter a maximum of 1 individual event.				
	• Entries will be processed in the order received and <u>accepted to</u> the greatest extent possible without exceeding the 4-hour/session timeline limit.

AWARDS:	No awards will be given for this meet.				
SEEDING:	The events will be swum fastest to slowest, alternating the 1000 Free and 400 IM.				
	Swimmers should report directly to the block for their events.				
	All events require a positive check-in to swim.				
	Positive check-in will close 30 minutes prior to the start of the session.				
PENALTIES:	A fine of up to \$100 per event may be assessed for any illegal participation in the meet. Illegal participation is defined as				
	<ul> <li>Entries using fraudulent or non-verifiable times.</li> </ul>				
	<ul> <li>Athlete competed in the incorrect age group.</li> <li>Athlete is not registered with USA Swimming prior to the first day of the meet.</li> </ul>				
	If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer.				
	Any event in which an athlete participated illegally will be rescored and re-awarded				
RULES:	The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy will apply.				
	<ul> <li>All adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (MAAPP) and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.</li> </ul>				
	Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present without written USA Swimming approval.				
	<ul> <li>Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USAS member coach as proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a USAS member coach, the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian must ensure compliance with this requirement.</li> </ul>				
	Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. In addition, photography behind the blocks is not permitted.				
	Changing, in whole or in part, into or out of swimsuit when wearing just one suit in an area other than in a locker room, bathroom, or other space designated for changing is PROHIBITED.				
	In accordance with VSI Best Practices, swimmers should shower before entering the pool.				
	An athlete suspected of sustaining a concussion or exhibiting signs of a concussion will immediately be removed from competition and shall not return to competition that day. The athlete may return to				

	competition on a subsequent day, but only with a release authorization signed by a licensed healthcare provider.				
	In accordance with Virginia Swimming Policy, only those coaches who have current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches with expired or non-current credentials will be required to leave the deck area
