	•	Meet Director reserves the right to utilize two courses once entries are received. Teams will be notified no later than Monday November 3, 2025 if two courses will be used.		
	•	Meets at the NOVA Aquatic Center – Regency will be fully staffed with American Red Cross certified Lifeguards at all times. There are also 2 AEDs on site as well first aid supplies located at several locations in the Facility. The Lifeguard Office has a full first aid kit as well as ice. The closest EMT is located at Henrico Fire Station #9 which is 1.1 miles away.		
	•	The meet host will ensure that the competition course meets the required dimensions as specified in 103.3 USA Swimming Rules and Regulations.

	Entries must be submitted in short course yard times using Commlink-2 software.

	<ul> <li>A printout of entries must be included or the meet checklist/summary sheet with the name of the person to contact in case of questions must accompany the entries, regardless of how they are submitted.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>All entry times must have been achieved in USA Swimming sanctioned, approved, or observed competition.</li> </ul>
	Teams may enter a maximum of 4 swimmers per event, except where noted in the event schedule
	Swimmers may enter a maximum of 6 events total, but no more than 2 per session.
	Teams may enter a maximum of 2 relay teams per relay event.
	• If a team cannot fill an event with 4 single age swimmers, athletes within the USA Swimming Motivational Time Standard defined age groups may be permitted to fill open single age entry slots. These swimmers will not count towards scoring. Contact the meet director to request this option.
	<ul> <li>Entries will be processed in the order received and <u>accepted to</u> the greatest extent possible without exceeding the 4-hour/session timeline.</li> </ul>

AWARDS:	<ul> <li>Individual Events: Medals will be awarded for first (1st) through third (3<sup>rd</sup>). Ribbons will be awarded fourth (4<sup>th</sup>) through eighth (8th) place for individual age groups</li> </ul>
	Relay Events: Awards will be presented to first (1st) through third (3rd) place for each event.
SEEDING:	<ul> <li>All events will be pre-seeded, except for the 500 Free, 1000 Free, and 400 IM which will require positive check in</li> </ul>
	Check in deadlines will be shared with teams no later than Wednesday October 29, 2025

	SWIMMERS FAILING TO POSITIVELY CHECK-IN WILL NOT BE SEEDED IN THE EVENT.
	Athletes who positively check in but fail to swim the event will be barred from all competition for the remainder of the session (both individual and relay events)
PENALTIES:	<ul> <li>A fine of up to \$100 per event may be assessed for any illegal participation in the meet. Illegal participation is defined as</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Entries using fraudulent or non-verifiable times.</li> <li>Athlete competed in the incorrect age group.</li> <li>Athlete is not registered with USA Swimming prior to the first day of the meet.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer.</li> </ul>
	Any event in which an athlete participated illegally will be rescored and re-awarded
RULES:	The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy, will govern this meet.
	<ul> <li>All adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (MAAPP) and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present without written USA Swimming approval.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USAS member coach as proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a USAS member coach, the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian must ensure compliance with this requirement.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. In addition, photography behind the blocks is <u>not permitted</u>.</li> </ul>
	• Changing, in whole or in part, into or out of a swimsuit when wearing just one suit in an area other than in a locker room, bathroom, or other space designated for changing is PROHIBITED.
	In accordance with VSI best practices, all swimmers should shower before entering the pool.
	<ul> <li>An athlete suspected of sustaining a concussion or exhibiting signs of a concussion will immediately be removed from competition and shall not return to competition that day. The athlete may return to competition on a subsequent day, but only with a release authorization signed by a licensed healthcare provider.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>In accordance with VSI Policy, only those coaches who have current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches with expired or non-current credentials will be required to leave the deck area.</li> </ul>
