OnDeck App

1. Download and install the On Deck App
2. Login using your ECAT sports engine user ID and password
3. Opening screen should say East Coast Aquatic Team, this is your dashboard and shows:
 - a. Finance information, you can see current billing information, and the credit card you have on file
 - b. Events and Jobs; you can see the upcoming events, and job sign-ups for meets
 - c. Links for USA Swimming and Safe Sport website
 - d. Cool Tools; stop watch, time converter, and pace calculator
4. The top left of the screen has 3 horizontal lines which take you to a menu of your access options. These are:
 - e. Membership, which has your account information, your swimmer(s) best times, and time standards to choose.
 - f. Finance information, same as the dashboard
 - g. Events and jobs information, same as the dashboard
 - h. Calendar and Classes, this is currently not being used
 - i. Safe Sport link, same as the dashboard
 - j. Team News, currently not being used
 - k. Settings and privacy, for your use
 - l. Help
 - m. Contact Us
 - n. Logout

Meet Mobile App

Download and install the Meet Mobile App. The free version allows you to see a version of the heat sheet. The paid version, \$6.99 annually, provides the results after the swims. The timing of results showing up on the app depend on the timing system used at each meet.

On the main screen you will have a search box to search for a particular meet, and or swimmers. The default screen will show the most recent meets that you have viewed. There is also a tab for searching for meets “near me.”

When searching for a meet, start with near me, or type the name of the meet into the search box. You can do a search by a partial name, or the full name of the meet. In addition, you can search by city name, or the name of the pool facility.

Once found, select the meet. The screen will show the full name of the meet, dates, and location. There are four viewing options at the bottom of the page.

Events: View the meet schedule and results. Selecting events provides all of the sessions by date and start time. Selecting a session will take you to the list of events for that session; listed by event number and name. Selecting the event will show you the heat sheet for that event, or the results if the event has finished. You can set up a filter to display only your swimmer, or a group of swimmers, or the entire ECAT team. Simply select the star next to a swimmer or team under those pages, then selecting the three vertical dots on the top right side of the screen, you can select filter, and then you will have the option to highlight favorite swimmers, or favorite teams. Selecting one a second time will de-select that option. For filtering on the events page, select the “funnel” on the upper right side of the screen, then you can pick favorite swimmers, or team.

Swimmers: Find swimmers and follow your favorites. Selecting swimmers will display every swimmer entered in the meet, alphabetically. The display default is all, but you can filter to just women, or just men. This is where you can identify favorite swimmers, by touching the star outline on the left of the screen, turning it to gold. Once you have identified all the swimmers you wish to highlight, touch the 3 vertical dots on the upper right, select filter, and select favorite swimmers. Only those with the gold star will appear. De-selecting the filter will display all swimmers again. Selecting a swimmer will provide their schedule of events, of if completed, their results. Selecting an event for a swimmer will show their entry information; entry time, heat, and lane. If the event has been completed, results information displayed will include time, splits, and overall place.

Teams: Track ECAT's progress. Selecting Teams will display all teams entered in the meet, alphabetically. You can filter this to any team you wish, simply touch the pennant with a star, turning the pennant gold for those teams you wish to follow. Then select the three vertical dots, select filter, and then favorite teams to list those teams. Selecting a team will display all the swimmers from that team entered in the meet. You can filter swimmers as outlined in the swimmer section above. Also, women and men filters are available. If you are new to ECAT, and competed in a meet as "unattached ECAT" you will have to scroll down to the "U" to select the unattached team.

Team Scores: View the overall team results of the meet. Generally, this is done at championship meets, such as, Districts, Regionals, Age Group, and Senior Championship meets where team awards are earned. Selecting team scores, all teams will be displayed. Filtering teams is done just as described under teams. In addition, women and men default filters are available. When team scores are kept, individual swimmers earning points will have their scores listed.
