- Coaches Report: Looking forward to Fall Fury, Winter Jr. National will be added to the schedule.
- II. Officer report:
 - A. President:
 - 1. We had 12 new members join CA. This is up three compared to July 23 and 1 more than Sept 24.
 - 2. A couple more people need to register.
 - B. Vice President:
 - 1. Fall Fury volunteer slots are 20% full.
 - 2. Need to send out reminder
 - 3. Working on T-Shirt designs. Order form for T-shirts and caps will be out soon.
 - 4. Need a concession lead.
 - C. Secretary:
 - Working on a list of days we will not have swim practice. Priscilla to work with Coach Taylor to help finish that list
 - D. Treasurer:
 - 1. Checks for IES Reimbursements have been deposited and those receiving a reimbursement have been given or sent a check.
 - E. WSU Head Coach
 - 1. CEO of USA swimming stepped down and a new CEO was named.
 - 2. IES will send two delegates to the House of Delegates.

- 3. Parents must be aware that checks can take up to a week to deposit. We will try to have them deposited on the 15th.
- D. Voted to remove registration fee for additional athletes per family per season. 4/4
 - 1. We had a hard time explaining and setting up registration
 - 2. Most families did not choose this option.
 - 3. Priscilla will put credits on the accounts she charged.
- IV. Stadium Clean Up Check In
 - A. Shared concerns about the leaf blowing
 - B. Significant increase in amount of work
 - C. Discussed if we wanted to keep trying or renegotiate terms of contract
 - D. We will decide after Sept 20th game
 - E. We will double the works hours for those who leaf blow
 - F. Ideas for improvement
