Held under the sanction of USA Swimming

It is understood and agreed that USA Swimming and Wisconsin Swimming, Inc. shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.

- Location: Waunakee HS Pool, 301 Community Dr., Waunakee, WI 53597
- Facility: Eight lanes, 25 yards flush deck, non-turbulence lane dividers and backstroke flags, with 29.75" height starting blocks. Pool is 7.5 feet deep at the starting blocks and 3.5 feet deep at the non starting end of the pool. The Meet host will ensure the required course dimensions.
100 yard relays will have the 2nd and 4th leg of the relay start in the water. There will be at least 2 lifeguards on duty during the meet, any medical attention that is needed please report to the main pool office off the southside of the pool.
- Timing: Colorado System 6 with backup watches. All events are timed finals. Computerized scoreboard for all lanes. Each 25 races will be timed with 1 button and 2 manual watches.
- Officials: Meet Referee: **Mike Peters** (michael.peters@wisc.edu) for PM session, and **Kreg Grindle** (kreg.grindle@gmail.com) for AM session. Admin Official: **John Schultz** (johnschulz1988@gmail.com). There will be at least four certified USA Swimming Officials on deck at all times.
- MAAPP: All adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. Times achieved by an athlete member at a sanctioned meet who is over 18 years of age who had not completed the Athlete Protection Training (or whose APT training had expired) by the date of the swim, will not be able to be uploaded to SWIMS. These athletes will also be considered "not in good standing" and can be subject to fines under Wisconsin Swimming Policy 11.2.1.
- Image Authorization: All participants agree to be filmed and photographed by the official photographer(s) and network(s) of Wisconsin Swimming and the meet host under the conditions authored by Wisconsin and USA Swimming, and allow event organizers the right to use names, pictures, likenesses, and biographical information before, during or after the

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period of participation in this Wisconsin Swimming competition to promote such competitions.

Rules:

This meet is sanctioned by USA Swimming and Wisconsin Swimming, Inc. All USA Swimming and WSI rules apply including safety rules, which will be strictly enforced. Swimmers must be registered Wisconsin USA-S swimmers. Age is as of the first day of competition. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. Swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming. Any non-LSC swimmers must be able to provide their current USA certification prior to swimming.

We reserve the right to alter any warm-up and meet start times; limit event sizes and eliminate any events that allow us to keep the meet timeline manageable. Events/heats may be combined as directed by the Meet Referee during the meet and by Meet Director for pre-meet seeding. Additional breaks may be added if needed as determined by the Meet Referee.

Warm-ups:

Warm ups for the meet will be determined upon final receipt of entries but not before 7:00am. Final determination of warm-up procedures and times will be released no later than Wednesday, November 12, 2025. "THREE POINT ENTRY" ONLY. Meet Director/Marshals will be on deck during the entire warm-up, with the authority to recommend disqualification. There will be a 10 minute in-water warm up before the 500 Free (Session 2) that will begin immediately following the end of Session 1. Session 3 will not begin before 11:00am. Events will begin 5 minutes after the close of warm up sessions. No equipment or other training devices are allowed during warm-ups. Swimmer(s) without a coach present are to report to the Meet Director prior to warm-ups for lane assignment.

There is a positive check in for the Open 500 free located under the pool scoreboard at the announcer table. Check in closes 30 minutes prior to the beginning of the 500's.

Swimmers may compete in 4 events not including relays. All teams are required to submit entries in the Hy-Tek CommLink format.

Deadline:

Emailed **Hy-Tek Entries are due Wednesday, November 5th by 6:00pm**. You will receive an e-mail confirmation of your entry within 48 hours.

If you have not received that confirmation, please contact the meet director via email.

Entries may be limited by the Meet Director to adhere to USA-S's Rule 205.3.1(F), i.e. the four hour session rule for 12 & Under athletes.

A meet timeline and psych sheet will be sent to the email address who submitted the entries prior to the meet, no later than Tuesday, November 12th.

Athletes that are requesting an accommodation and/or modification, shall present the [WSI Para Accommodation Form](#) to the meet referee and/or meet director prior to the meet start.

There are no deck entries allowed.

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- Admissions: There will be no admission fee at the door. It is included in the \$13 meet surcharge.
- Heat sheets will be made available Friday, November 14th by 12pm.
- Deck USAS Registration WAUN will not accept deck USAS registration. An unregistered swimmer may not compete.
- Age Groups: 8 and Under, 10 and Under, 11-12, Open. Age as of the first day of the meet.
- Awards & Scoring: Individual Events, places 1st thru 16th: 20, 17, 16, 15, 14, 13, 12, 11, 9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1.
Relay Events, places 1st thru 8th: 40, 34, 32, 30, 28, 26, 24, 22.
Awards for relay events will consist of ribbons for 1st–8th place. Awards for individual events will consist of ribbons for 1st–16th place. Coaches will be permitted to pick up awards at the end of each session. Awards will not be mailed.
- Coaches: All coaches can pick up heat sheets, relay sheets and any other pertinent information at the timing table on the pool deck. **Any monies still owed must be paid before you can obtain your packet. Coaches will need to show up to date credentials and sign in before receiving team packets or being allowed on the pool deck.**
- Concession: A selection of hot and cold food and drinks will be available throughout the day.
- Meet Conduct: Flyover starts will be used. All teams are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers. The Meet Director/Marshall, at his/her discretion, shall remove any swimmers or spectators who behave in a disruptive or disorderly manner. All coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and will see that their club has proper supervision at all times. Meet Marshals have the authority to remove any swimmer and/or spectator from the meet for any violation such as improper behavior, damage to property, etc. No smoking on the premises. Please encourage your parents and swimmers to clean up after themselves.
Deck changes are prohibited.
Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms or locker rooms.

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Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
