## **Code of Conduct: Coach**

The purpose of this revised code of conduct for coaches is to establish common expectations for all members of the coaching staff of Mako Aquatics ("Coach"). It is to be used as a guide to promote an environment of respect and safety for all participants in Mako Aquatics; including athletes, coaches, officials, parents and volunteers.

	Always maintain a professional separation between Coach and athlete.		
	At all times, adhere to USA Swimming's rules and code of conduct.		
	At all times, adhere to any requirements imposed by the U.S. Center for SafeSport		
	One-on-One interactions (with unrelated minor athletes), including Social Media Interactions

	<ul> <li>One-on-one interactions between a minor athlete and Coach (who is not the minor's</li> </ul>		
	legal guardian) must occur at an observable and interruptible distance from another adult or under		
	emergency circumstances.		
	Meetings		
	☐ Meetings between a minor athlete and Coach may only occur if another adult is present		
	and where interactions can be easily observed and at an interruptible distance from another adult,		
	except under emergency circumstances.		
	☐ If a one-on-one meeting takes place, the door to the room must remain unlocked and		
	open. If available, it must occur in a room that has windows, with the windows, blinds, and/or curtains		
	remaining open during the meeting.		
	☐ Meetings must not be conducted in a Coach's or athlete's hotel room or other overnight		
	lodging location during team travel.		
_	Individual Training Sessions		
	☐ Individual training sessions outside of the regular course of training and practice between Coach and minor athletes are permitted if the training session is observable and interruptible		
	by another adult. Legal guardians must be allowed to observe the training session.		
	Social Media and Electronic Communications		
_	☐ All electronic communication from Coach to minor athletes must be professional in		
	nature.		
	☐ Open and Transparent - Absent emergency circumstances, if a Coach needs to		
	communicate directly with a minor athlete via electronic communications (including social media), the		
	minor athlete's legal guardian must be copied. If a minor athlete communicates to the Coach privately		
	first, said Coach must copy the minor athlete's legal guardian on any electronic communication		
	response to the minor athlete.		
	☐ When a Coach communicates electronically to the entire team, said Coach must copy		
	another adult. When possible use the TU platform (including OnDeck app) to communicate.		
	☐ Legal guardians may request in writing that their minor athlete not be contacted through		
	any form of electronic communication by the club or by a Coach subject to this Policy. The organization		
	must abide by any such request that the minor athlete not be contacted via electronic communication, or		
	included in any social media post, absent emergency circumstances.		

	Electronic communications must only be sent between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00	
o.m., unless e	mergency circumstances exist, or during competition travel.	
	Prohibited Electronic Communication - Coach is not permitted to maintain private social	
media connec	tions with unrelated minor athletes and such Coach is not permitted to accept new	
personal page requests on social media platforms from minor athletes. Existing social media		
connections w	ith minor athletes must be discontinued. Minor athletes may follow the club's official page.	
	Coach must not send private, instant or direct messages to a minor athlete through	
social media p	latforms.	
	If electronic communication is initiated by athlete; responses should include another	
coach or pare	nt/guardian and follow communication guidelines outlined above

	Local Travel - Local travel consists of travel to training, practice and competition that	
occurs locally	and does not include coordinated overnight stay(s).	
	Coach must not ride in a vehicle alone with an unrelated minor athlete, absent	
emergency circumstances, and must always have at least two minor athletes or another adult in the		
ehicle, unless	s otherwise agreed to in writing by the minor athlete's legal guardian. (A Consent to Travel	
	vailable if needed)	
-	e of respect, sportsmanship and safety for participants and fans to follow	
Respect offici	ials and their judgment and abide by the rules of the event.	
Treat opposir	ng coaches, participants, and spectators with respect.	
Instruct partic	sipants in sportsmanship and demand that they display respect and good sportsmanship.

Always place	the well-being, health, and safety of swimmers above all other considerations, including
