HSSB Code of Conduct: Coaches

The purpose of this code of conduct for coaches is to establish common expectations for all member of the coaching staff. It is to be used as a guide to promote a positive team environment and good sportsmanship.

Adhere to USA Swimming's rules and code of conduct at all times.
Set a good example of respect that the athletes and parents can follow.
Be passionate, engaged, and full of feedback.
Act professional and with dignity.
Respect officials and their judgement. Treat other coaches and athletes with respect.
Tell the athletes about good sportsmanship and set a good example (i.e. shaking hands
after a race).
Be positive at practice and meets and do not use derogatory or abusive language.
Inappropriate physical contact of any kind is not tolerated at all and will result in
termination.
Treat all athletes the same.
Safety of the swimmers is our number one priority.
Always maintain a professional separation between coach and athlete.

Any complaints of a coach violating this code of conduct will be brought to the attention of the board of directors.
