ENTRY DEADLINE:

ENTRY FEES:

and the waiver form signed. Money used for reservations is

DECK ENTRIES: Deck entries will be accepted if open lanes are available and

number of entries permit. Parents should come to the crow's nest to complete the forms. Swimmers wishing to deck enter must have their current USA Swimming ID available. There will be no deck registration

for the meet.

WARM-UPS: Friday warm up session will be 30 minutes unassigned with 5 minutes of

closed pool time. The Saturday/Sunday morning and afternoon warm-up sessions will be 60 minutes long, split into two sessions with 5 minutes of closed pool time before the meet starts. **Host team will assign warm up**

lanes.

USA Swimming and Wisconsin Swimming warm-up procedures will be enforced throughout the meet. Warm-ups are subject to the following

procedures:

Circle swimming only, entry into the water shall be feet first three-point entry for all competition, except in designated lanes and times. Teams are allowed to do starts, sprint and pace work within their assigned warm-up time. No snorkels, kickboards or other training devices are

allowed during warm-ups.

Swimmer(s) without a coach present are to report to the Meet Director

prior to warm-ups for lane assignment.

Violators of the Wisconsin Swimming warm-up procedures may be

subject to disqualification.

SEEDING: All age groups will be pre-seeded.

ELIGIBILITY: Swimmers must be current USA Swimming members, in good standing,

and the USA numbers must appear on the entry form/disk.. Out of state entrants must bring their USA swimming cards and be prepared to show them to the Meet Director. Swimmers wishing to deck enter must have

their current USA Swimming ID card available.

DISABLED SWIMMERS:

Athletes shall present an <u>accommodation/modification form</u> to the Meet Director or Meet Referee to assist with any athlete requests.

FOOD:

subject to fines under Wisconsin Swimming Policy 11.2.1.

COACH'S
