ENTRY DEADLINE: Completed individual and relay entry forms, waiver and fees must be received no later than September 19th, 2025. ENTRY FEES:

WARM-UPS:

ELIGIBILITY:

The morning and afternoon warm-up sessions will be 60 minutes long, split into two sessions with 5 minutes of closed pool time before the meet starts. Host team will assign warm up lanes.

USA Swimming and Wisconsin Swimming warm-up procedures will be enforced throughout the meet. Warm-ups are subject to the following procedures: Circle swimming only, entry into the water shall be feet first three-point entry for all competition, except in designated lanes and times. Teams are allowed to do starts, sprint and pace work within their assigned warm-up time. No snorkels, kickboards or other training devices are allowed during warm-ups.

Swimmer(s) without a coach present are to report to the Meet Director prior to warm-ups for lane assignment.

Violators of the Wisconsin Swimming warm-up procedures may be subject to disqualification.

SEEDING: All age groups will be pre-seeded.

> Swimmers must be current USA Swimming members, in good standing, and the USA numbers must appear on the entry form/disk. Out of state entrants must bring their USA swimming cards and be prepared to show them to Meet Director. Swimmers wishing to deck enter must have their current USA Swimming ID card

available. NO USA Swimming Deck registrations will be allowed

SWIMMERS: Athletes shall present an <u>accommodation/modification form</u> to the Meet Director

or Meet Referee to assist with any athlete requests.

FOOD: A concession stand will offer a wide selection of food and beverages available

outside the pool area. No food or coolers will be allowed in pool area.

CONDUCT: All teams will be responsible for the conduct of their own swimmers. The Meet

Marshall and Meet Director shall have authority to disqualify swimmers for misconduct. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is

not permitted in changing areas, restrooms or locker rooms.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement

Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited.

Deck changes are prohibited

Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the Program Operations Vice Chair.

All participants agree to be filmed and photographed by the official photographer(s) and network(s) of Wisconsin Swimming and the meet host under the conditions authored by Wisconsin and USA Swimming, and allow event organizers the right to use names, pictures, likenesses, and biographical information before, during or after the period of participation in this Wisconsin Swimming competition to promote such competitions.

Times achieved by an athlete member at a sanctioned/approved meet who is over 18 years of age who had not completed the Athlete Protection Training (or whose

APT training had expired) by the date of the swim, will not be able to be uploaded to SWIMS. This includes participation as a member of a relay. These athletes will also be considered "not in good standing" and can be subject to

fines under Wisconsin Swimming Policy 11.2.1.

COACH'S

that are on the deck for all sanctioned meets. Coaches not in good standing WILL NOT be allowed on the pool deck. They are allowed to be in the spectator stands

but NOT on the pool deck. Coach must sign in.
