Timing	All events will be timed using a Colorado timing system with horn start, touch pads (primary), button (secondary), and two watches as backup.
	For 25y events: Swimmers will start at the blocks and finish at the bulkhead (timing by two buttons with two watches as backup). The Meet Director reserves the right to reverse the starting and finishing ends pending any timing equipment issues. Any changes will be immediately communicated to participants and coaches.
Rules	This meet is sanctioned by USA Swimming and Wisconsin Swimming, Inc. All USA Swimming and WSI rules apply including safety rules, which will be strictly enforced.
	All athletes must be registered USA Swimming members. Age is as of November 21, 2025.
	Out of state entrants must bring a valid USA Swimming card and present it to the Meet Director prior to swimming.
	Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
	All adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy

("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. Times achieved by an athlete member at a sanctioned/approved meet who is over 18 years of age who had not completed the Athlete Protection Training (or whose APT training had expired) by the date of the swim, will not be able to be uploaded to SWIMS. This includes participation as a member of a relay. These athletes will also be considered "not in good standing" and can be subject to fines under Wisconsin Swimming Policy 11.2.1.
