



Moving dryland from daily extra time with deck coaches to more of a structured format with dryland professionals.


Dryland will resume at the start of the winter session.

- 13-Over State Meet 3/3-3/6 (Brown Deer)


Competition Suit

- Old suit was abruptly discontinued

- If you need a new suit, get this one!
- While I like everyone looking uniform, its not a requirement to own



Technical Suits/Practice Suits

- I put a lot of information on swimsuits/equipment on the team page. If you haven't looked lately, take a look.
- Practice suits should be comfortable; meet suits should not be. Straps should be very snug on women's suits, there should be no wrinkles in male or female suits.
- Not everyone needs a tech suit! Talk to coaches.



Jackets/Parkas

- The vast majority of our swimmers were not prepared for the cold pool decks & adjacent hallways/gyms at meets last season.
- Middleton has team jackets & parkas available at the store, on their website, and will have them on hand when they come to SPHS on Thursday, September 10th from 5:30-7:30pm



Equipment

- All other equipment needed (fins, pull buoys, gear bags) is listed on the team website. Look under "Swim Groups" for the Equipment Needs tab.
- Middleton will have everything needed except for racquetballs for Typhoon/Tsunami swimmers



Monthly Clinics

- Once a month, we'll offer a 60 minute Saturday morning clinic for our 10under swimmers.
- The clinics will be led by me, with 3-4 assistant coaches/Tsunami swimmers helping.
- The cost to sign up is \$20; signup is reserved for the first 20 interested swimmers (signup windows will be announced in advance)
- Each month will be a different focus. September's clinic is 9/12 and focuses on freestyle.

Masters Group

- Offering a Masters Group at SPHS for all interested swimmers over the age of 18
- Swimmers should be able to complete 100 yds of freestyle with proper side breathing. Knowing other techniques: awesome.
- · Great for fitness, cross-training, or open water preparation
- Offered starting Wed, Sept 9th. Mon/Wed/Thur mornings 5:30-6:45AM
- Cost: Annual USA Reg of \$75, monthly fee is \$50
- Already 5 swimmers committed, hoping to get 10!
