



1) Increased Brand Recognition

- Hosted BCSC Championship Meet, bringing 200+ swimmers to Sun Prairie first their first time
- Saturdays & Socials Membership created pipeline for BCSC swimmers to participate on Storm
- Regularly attended Chamber of Commerce networking events
- Led USA Swimming webinar on Swim School Challenge

2) Additional Partnerships in Community

- Through Swim School Challenges, have created a network to develop swimmers from lessons to competitive swimming
- Sponsored Sun Prairie Piranhas and Monona Water Wizards, along with other programs in the community
- Helped local teams host swim meets through our "meet in a box" solution
- Volunteered at Sunshine Supper
- Typhoon swimmers organized clothing drive for Cards Closet

3) Fill volunteer roles

- While some committee chair positions remain open, we have filled some and moved others to paid positions (ex: bookkeeper & Meet Director)
- Still need help with:

4) Increase offerings w/o increasing fees

- The expansion of Rising Stars meets throughout the year have given opportunities for our younger swimmers to swim over a half dozen meets this year for only \$5 each
- The newly created Highway 19 Alliance between Watertown, Storm Aquatics, and DFAC is creating fast and affordable swim meets throughout the year

Goals for 2025-2026 Season

- Work with partners to rebuilding swimming on Sun Prairie's
 East side
- Find businesses willing to sponsor specific swim meets and other non-traditional partnerships
- Stabilize registration numbers for boys, specifically age 10-14
