Please read the <u>full meet worker</u> policy available on the team's website. Click on "Current Season and Info" and look under Forms & Documents. It describes the meet worker rationale, obligations and sign up process for each of these meets.

Mandatory Meets - All families must provide workers (even if your swimmer is not involved in the meet or withdraws from the team before the end of the season). The number of work sessions for each mandatory meet will be determined by the Board of Directors. Exception: Swimmers who START THE SEASON in our Novice program (PCSC or Ribbon) and advance to our Age Group Bronze or Super 8 program during the season will receive a reduced requirement for the first mandatory meet after their advancement.

If you are unable to work the required number of sessions for a meet, you will be charged a "buyout fee." Buyout fees range from \$40-\$100 per session. Signing up to work a session and then not showing up results in a charge of two times the session buyout fee.
