Parent Meet Worker Policy

During the upcoming 2024 long course season, Lake Country Swim Team (LCST) will host the following meets. Additional participant family required meets may be added as needed. The following chart shows the meet worker responsibilities for LCST families.

Please read the full meet worker policy available on the team's website; click here for that document. It describes the meet worker rationale, obligations and sign up process for each of these meets.

Mandatory Meets – <u>All</u> families must provide workers (<u>even if your swimmer is not involved in the meet or withdraws from the team before the end of the season</u>). These meets provide significant revenue to the team's general fund, which benefits all families. Therefore, we require all families to contribute service to these events. The number of work sessions for each mandatory meet will be determined by the Board of Directors. *Exception: New families that have just moved up to the competitive swim team* (Super 8 or Age Group) from the novice program during this long course season (March-July) will have a reduced requirement.

If you are unable to work the required number of sessions for a meet you may pay the session buyout fee instead of working. For meets where service is required for all participant families, the fee is \$40 per session. For MANDATORY SERVICE MEETS the session buyout starts at \$80 and increases for each additional session.
