## Family Service Requirements

There are two separate service requirements for members of the Lake Country Swim Team. Detailed explanations and policies for each are available on the website. The two programs are separate and families must meet the requirements of both programs. A brief explanation of each is below.

### Seasonal Service Program

The seasonal service program requires all member families to pay a service deposit at the start of each season. Families may earn back the deposit as a credit on their account by signing up for and completing the required number of service points. Most families are required to deposit \$100 and earn 45 points worth of service in a season. Points are awarded in blocks of 15, with some service options earning the entire 45 points. Newer team members, those in Age Group Bronze, Age Group Silver, Super 8 and Hartford JV make a \$50 deposit and need to earn 15 points to meet their requirement. ### Meet Service Program

The meet service program requires all member families to serve the team by working at some of the meets we host. Some of these meets are mandatory service meets, meaning all families must contribute workers for the meet. Other meets are participation service meets, which requires that all participants in the meet provide a worker for the session during which the swimmer competes. We also have some meets where there is no work requirement, and we count on the willingness of our families to help out as needed. You have the option of buying out of mandatory and participation service obligations.
