Working at Lake Country Phoenix Hosted Swim Meets

There are three levels of Lake Country hosted meets. We need your help to run all three levels. Our premier meets, which generate more than a quarter of our annual revenue, require full team mandatory service. Our standard hosted multi-team meets require participant service. Our smaller local meets require volunteer service from available members.

Mandatory Full Team Service Meets:

Proceeds from these premier meets help keep our training fees reasonable. Since we all benefit financially, we are all required to volunteer our time. These meets are run at **Walter Schroeder Aquatic Center in Brown Deer**.

Our upcoming mandatory team service meet dates are shown below. There is only one such meet this season; please mark your calendar. The board will establish the number of sessions required for EACH family (usually 2 or 3). Meet sign-ups will be posted under the "Current Events" tab on our website. Buyout fees for these meets are: - \$100 for each session.

Mandatory Participant Service Meets

These meets require the help of participating families. Service is required ONLY if your swimmer is entered in that meet. Families who have a swimmer participating in a meet, but are unable to volunteer should choose the buyout option. Buyouts will range from \$35-\$70/session.

Optional Volunteer Meets

These are intra-team or two team meets at Arrowhead high school where about 30 volunteers are needed. If you are a parent new to competitive swimming, volunteering to help at these meets can train you for volunteer jobs at our bigger meets. The meet does not begin until all volunteer positions are filled.

- LAKE Distance Time trial (12/16)

Buy Out/Late Fees

For those on vacation or with previous commitments (weddings, family reunions, etc.) - you may take a buy out or request pre-meet work (4-6 hours of shopping, baking, cooking, etc. per session – pre-meet work may be available for larger meets). Also assigned on a first come/first serve basis. Limited availability.

Job sign up is done on-line. Job sign-up opening date and time for Mandatory Full Team Service Meets will be posted several days in advance. To get your desired shift and job, you should be on-line signing up as soon it opens – preferred positions and times get taken early. To sign up:
