Facility: Eight 7-foot lanes, 25 yard pool with non-turbulent lane markers and backstroke flags, recessed deck, 30-inch high fixed starting blocks, 4'9 to 5'0 pool depth at starting end. 4' pool depth at non-starting end. Balcony seating for 320. All events will start at the starting end, including 8 & under events. The 2nd and 4th swimmers in 100 yard relays will start in the water from the non-starting block end. The meet host will ensure the required course dimensions.

Timing: Electronic timing system with touch pads and manual back-up buttons and horn start. Each lane will have two (2) timers with electronic stopwatches. Athletes competing in 25 yard events will be timed using only 2 manual watches.

Rules: Official 2025 Short Course USA-S Rules prevail at this meet. Age is as of October 11th, 2025. This meet is approved by USA Swimming and Wisconsin Swimming, Inc. All USA Swimming and WSI rules apply including safety rules, which will be strictly enforced.

All participants agree to be filmed and photographed by the official photographer(s) and network(s) of Wisconsin Swimming and the meet host under the conditions authored by Wisconsin and USA Swimming, and allow event organizers the right to use names, pictures, likenesses, and biographical information before, during or after the

period of participation in this Wisconsin Swimming competition to promote such competitions. Deck changes are prohibited.

Racing Start Certification:

Any swimmer entered in the meet, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Warm-ups:

Saturday AM: 8:00-9:00am

Saturday PM: 45 minutes at the conclusion of session 1

Warm-ups will be 60 minutes in length for morning and 30 minutes for afternoon sessions. Warm-up lane assignments with times will be emailed to participating teams.

Circle swimming only, except in designated lanes and times. All entry to pools during open warm-up cool down periods shall be feet first three-point entry from the start end. No snorkels, kickboards or other training devices are allowed during warm-ups. Teams should plan to do starts, sprint and pace work within their assigned warm-up time. Swimmer(s) without a coach present are to report to the Meet Director prior to warm-ups for lane assignment

Seeding:

This is a pre-seeded meet. It is the swimmer's responsibility to be at the blocks at the start of his/her events.

Entries & Eligibility:

Individuals may enter 3 individual events in each session plus ONE relay, for a total of 6 events for the day plus 2 relays. A team may enter an unlimited number of relays in any relay event. The meet is open to registered and non-registered swimmers. USA-S ID Numbers are entered in the meet only for those swimmers who are USA Swimming members, in good standing. This is an early meet, so please make sure your USA memberships are up-to-date if applicable.

Swimmers with special needs should be noted on your entry form. Your coach is also responsible for notifying the head official during warm-ups of any special needs of your swimmers. Use of the WSI Para Accommodation Form is required for all accommodation and/or modification requests.

Deck entries allowed for open lanes only. Swimmers must be entered in the meet. Deck entries \$10

Mixed Relays can allow gender combination of 3/1 genders.

Entry Deadline: Entries must be received by the Entry Chair by **Wednesday, October 1, 2025** via a Hy-tek file thru email to bloomier79@yahoo.com No phone entries will be accepted. A hard copy must be sent either by mail or email so all entries can be double checked.

Entry Fees: \$6.00 per individual event, \$12.00 per Relay. Splash fee \$4.00, \$10 facility fee, \$10 Admission fee

Admissions: Included in Entry Fees. Heat sheets will be available online.

Final Results: A copy of the meet's results will be sent to each team. A meet back-up and results will be posted on the Wisconsin swimming website

Concessions: A variety of food items and drinks will be available at the meet.

Conduct: All coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and will see that their club has proper supervision at all times. Meet Marshals have the authority to remove any swimmer and/or spectator from the meet for any violation such as improper behavior, damage to property, etc. No smoking on the premises. Please encourage your parents and swimmers to clean up after themselves.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in the changing areas, restrooms, or locker rooms. Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited. Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. Deck changes are prohibited.

MAAPP:

All adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. Times achieved by an athlete member at a sanctioned/approved meet who is over 18 years of age who had not completed the Athlete Protection Training (or whose APT training had expired) by the date of the swim, will not be able to be uploaded to SWIMS. This includes participation as a member of a relay. These athletes will also be considered "not in good standing" and can be subject to fines under Wisconsin Swimming Policy 11.2.1.
