Rules: U.I.L. and NFHS rules will govern the meet.

Scoring: Individual Events: 20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1
Relay Events: 40-34-32-30-28-26-24-22-18-14-12-10-8-6-4-2

Awards: Team awards will be given to the first place girls' team and the first place boys' team. Medals will be awarded to first, second, and third place in individual and relay events. Ribbons will be awarded to fourth through eighth place in individual and relay events.

Entries: Each contestant may enter a maximum of four (4) events. No more than two (2) may be individual events (diving counts as an individual event). Top six (6) in each event from the District Championships will qualify for the Region Championships. Dive sheets must be entered on www.cleanentries.com by the entry deadline.

Entry Procedure: District Meet Directors shall e-mail the Hy-tek "Advancers" file (top six in each event, including divers) and a pdf hard copy of your District Meet Results to Jenna Purkey at jennap@comaquatics.com. These should be submitted no later than 12:00 noon, Monday, February 2, 2024.

Coaches, please follow the directives listed below when submitting your district entries, as that database will follow your team and athletes all the way to the State Meet.

- Use the official UIL Team Code.
- Use the numeric grade level (09, 10, 11, 12) for each athlete.
- Use the School Name as listed on the UIL alignment page
- Do not use a mascot name or shortened name.

Scratches: It is the responsibility of the coach making the scratch to notify the coach of the first alternate, and the Region Meet Director of their intention to scratch an individual or relay. It is the responsibility of the coach of the alternate to notify the Region Meet Director their intention to compete or not compete.

USAS: This meet will be approved for observation by USA Swimming for NTV purposes.

Only times achieved by swimmers who are currently registered with USA Swimming, have an accurate and complete USA Swimming ID Number in the Meet Manager Database, correct spelling of name, and conform to the technical rules will be loaded into the SWMS Database. The athlete's USA swimming ID must be included in your entry file. The meet host will not add them manually.

This means you must have the swimmer's USAS # on the District Meet entry file you submit to the District Meet Director.

All USA Swimming athletes 18 years of age and older must have completed the USAS Athlete Protection Training for their times to be loaded into the SWMS database.

Entry Fees: Entry fees are \$18.00 per individual regardless of the number of events entered, and \$18.00 per relay team entered in the meet. **Entry fees or proof of the requisition of fees must be received prior to competition.**

Deadlines: District Meet directors shall submit their Hy-tek “Advancer” file, all dive entries on www.cleandives.com and pdf hard copy of District results to the Region Meet Director no later than 12:00 noon, Monday, February 3rd 2025

Scratch Deadline – 11:59 pm, Tuesday, February 4th. Scratches received after the deadline will be considered a DFS in prelims and will count toward the athlete’s maximum number of entries.
