2023 GIL WILLIAMS MEMORIAL HALLOWEEN MEET HOSTED BY MERCED SKIMMERS

Held under the sanction of USA Swimming and CCS #S19523JO SATURDAY and SUNDAY, OCTOBER 21 & 22, 2023

Entries due by 11:59pm Saturday, October 14, 2023; see www.centralcalswim.org for meet information and Hy-Tek Entry File. Late entries will be accepted until 11:59pm Wednesday, October 18, 2023, with a \$10 late fee/swimmer

Location:

MERCED COLLEGE, 3600 M Street, Merced, California. From the South, take Hwy 99 to Mission Avenue/Campus Parkway (Exit 185). From the off-ramp, turn right and take Campus Parkway 4 ½ miles to Yosemite Avenue and use the roundabout to turn left (West) on to Yosemite Avenue. Go 2 ½ miles on Yosemite Avenue to G Street. Merced College will be on your right. From the North, take Hwy 99 to the V Street / R Street exit. Proceed to R Street, turn left (North) and take R Street 2 ½ miles to Yosemite Avenue and turn right. Go one mile. Merced College will be on the left.

Facility:

8-lane 25-yard outdoor course with a min depth of 4ft. Continuous warm-up will be available. Electronic timing system will be used. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2c (4) USAS rules and regulations.

Propane heaters are prohibited. Smoking and the use of tobacco products are prohibited on the pool deck, locker rooms, spectator areas and all areas used by swimmers. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Operation of a drone, or other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pool, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms at any time. For Athlete Protection, Central California Swimming prohibits the use of photography and audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, behind starting blocks throughout the duration of the meet. **Deck changes are prohibited**.

Format:

This is a short course timed final age group meet. Swimmers may compete in up to 4 individual events per day. The competition course may be modified to fit a 4-hour timeline. If the timeline runs beyond 4 hours, the meet may be changed to a "split session" format at the discretion of the Meet Referee. If so, session divisions will be announced by Wednesday, October 18, 2023.

Events 1-44 and 47-86 will be "*preseeded*," meaning there is no check-in necessary for these events. Heats will be seeded <u>fastest to slowest</u>. Events 45, 46, 87, 88, 89, and 90 will be deck seeded and heats will be run fastest to slowest alternating girls then boys. **Swimmers in events 45, 46, 87, 88, 89, and 90 must check-in for these events.** Swimmers in the 500, 1000, and 1650 yard freestyle events must provide their own timer, lap counter, and a lap counting device. Events may be combined, regardless of age or gender, at the discretion of the Meet Referee.

Time: Warm-ups start at 7:30 a.m. Meet starts at 9:00 a.m. for both days

Rules: Current USA Swimming and CCS Rules will govern the meet.

- Safe "3-point" entries must be used when entering the water for warm-up and warm-down.
- All coaches and officials must be able to show proof that USA Swimming membership requirements
 are met as of the date of competition. Such proof shall be presented upon request to the Meet
 Referee and may be in the form of USAS coach or official membership card or through SWIMS 3.0.
- Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
- Per USA Swimming and Central California Swimming policy, swimmers 12 years old and younger are not permitted to wear "Technical" suits at any CCS sanctioned or approved meets. For a detailed definition of the suits included in this policy:

Eligibility:

All swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming for 2023 or 2024 within 36 hours of the start of the meet (October 19 by noon). All current USA Swimming registered swimmers are welcome regardless of team and/or LSC affiliation. All entrants' membership will be verified through the USA Swimming database. SWIMS 3.0 is acceptable proof of USA Swimming membership. Swimmers must compete in their age group. Age on the first day of the meet determines age throughout the competition. **No deck entries will be allowed.**

Warm-Up: Warm-up procedures will be posted on the deck and announced by the Deck and Starter Referees

GENERAL WARM-UP PERIOD (first 30 minutes)

• All lanes open for general warm-up - no diving or sprints. **SPECIFIC WARM-UP PERIOD** (following general warm-up):

- <u>Lanes 1 and 8</u>: Push off one or two lengths up and back, beginning at starting end of pool. **Circle swimming only no diving.**
- Lanes 2 and 7: Dive start only, all swimmers begin at starting end of pool and swim one length.
- Lanes 3, 4, 5, and 6: General warm-up Circle swimming only no diving or sprints.

Unaccompanied

Athlete:

All USAS athlete members must be under the supervision of a USAS member coach during warm up, competition and warm-down. Swimmers who do not have a USAS registered coach at the swim meet should report to the Meet Director or Meet Referee for lane and coach assignment. It is the swimmers responsibility to make such arrangements prior to the start of the meet. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When accompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Entries:

Team entries should be sent in a Hy-Tek CL2 entry file to the following email address: mercedskimmers@gmail.com. Unattached swimmers affiliated with CCS may enter this meet on the CCS website, as long as the swimmer had registered on the CCS site for their USA Swimming membership. CCS Outreach swimmers who are entered in this meet will have their fees deducted by the Host Club. The Home Club or responsible individual of the Outreach swimmer is responsible for communicating with the Host Team of their roster and fees that need to be deducted. Names of the athletes who are receiving the Outreach incentive may be kept confidential at the discretion of the athletes' Home Club.

Deadline: Entries are due by 11:59pm, Saturday, October 14, 2023. Late entries will be accepted until 11:59pm

Wednesday, October 18, 2023, with a \$10 late fee per swimmer. No deck entries will be allowed.

Entry Fees: \$4.00 for each individual event, \$12.00 surcharge per swimmer. \$10.00 per swimmer for late entries.

No refunds.

Awards: Individual event awards will be made for 1st through 8th A/B/C Divisions. Individual awards for 15 & Over

will be made only upon request. Note: In events where 6 & under will swim with the 7 & 8 age group, swimmers will be scored and awarded separately; 13-14 and 15& Over will swim together but will

be scored and awarded separately. There will be no high point or team awards.
