Facility: Bullard High School Aquatics Complex, 5445 N Palm Avenue, Fresno, CA 93704

7 competition lanes, 6" lane lines with a minimum pool depth of 6.5 feet. Paragon starting blocks and Colorado Timing Systems electronic timing. Three 17 yard lanes and one 50-meter lane for continuous warm-up and swim down. **The competition course has been certified according to article 104.2.2C (4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.**

Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. For Athlete Protection, Central California Swimming prohibits the use of photography and audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, behind the starting blocks throughout the meet. No RV overnight parking allowed by Fresno Unified policy. Propane heaters are prohibited. Deck changes are prohibited.

Location: From the north take Hwy 99 south to Herndon Ave exit. At the stoplight at the end of the ramp, turn left (east) on Herndon to Palm Avenue. At Palm, turn right (south). At the fourth light, turn right (west) onto Browning Ave, then turn left into the student parking lot. From the south take Hwy 99 north. Exit onto Hwy 41 north. Exit Bullard Avenue. At top of off-ramp, turn left (west) and proceed to Palm Avenue. Turn left (south) on Palm Ave. At the next light, turn right onto Browning Ave, and turn left into the student parking lot.

Time: Saturday and Sunday warm-up begins at 7:00 a.m. Timed finals will begin at 8:30 a.m.

Rules: Current USA Swimming and CCS Rules will govern the meet. This is a timed finals meet. All coaches and officials must be able to show proof that USA Swimming membership requirements are met as of the date of the competition. Such proof shall be presented upon request to the Meet Referee and may be in the form of USAS membership card or through Deck Pass. All swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming for 2024. Swimmers must compete in their age group. Age on the first day of the meet determines age throughout the competition.

Relays will be deck-seeded with the entry deadline established by the Meet Referee each day. Relays will be swum at the end of individual events on Saturday and Sunday. "Relay Only" swimmers must enter on-line and pay the entry surcharge by the entry deadline. **All relays must be paid for by 11:00 a.m. on Sunday.**

The meet will be pre-seeded. All events will be seeded according to submitted times. Submitted entry times must be equal to or better than the listed time standards. Verification of entered times should be available upon request from the Meet Referee. Swimmers may enter and compete in up to 4 individual events per day, plus one relay. Eight and under swimmers may enter the two 10 and under events, but individual points earned will not count toward 8 and under high point.

In the event that the timeline exceeds the limits of the USA Swimming "4-hour rule," swimmers who enter the maximum number of events on either day must indicate with the Clerk of Course one event to scratch on their entry. Swimmers will indicate their choice of event to scratch upon check-in of their first event on the day(s) that the scratch down is necessary. If the swimmer does not indicate an event to scratch upon check-in of the first event, the last event of the day will be scratched by the Clerk of Course. Events may be combined regardless of age or gender at the discretion of the Meet Referee.

All USAS athlete members must be under the supervision of a USAS member coach during warm up, competition and warm-down. Swimmers who do not have a USAS registered coach at the swim meet should report to the Deck Referee for lane and coach assignment. It is the swimmer's responsibility to make such arrangements prior to the start of the meet.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

TECHNICAL SUITS: No technical suits shall be worn by any 12 & Under athlete member in competition at any sanctioned, approved, or observed CCS Meet. This includes any suit with bonded or taped seams regardless of its fabric or silhouette or any suit with woven fabric extending past the hips. (Note: Woven Fabric – A suit with woven fabric and sewn seams that does not extend below the hips is permitted. Knit fabric – A suit with knit fabric and sewn seams not extending below the knees is permitted). Warm-Up: GENERAL WARM-UP PERIOD - The first 30 minutes of warm-up will be for general warm-up in all lanes. There will be no diving allowed during general warm-up. ***All swimmers shall enter the pool with a three-point entry for all warm up and warm down.*** SPECIFIC WARM-UP PERIOD - The last 45 minutes of warm-up in the competition course will be allocated for specific warm-up in designated lanes. During the specific warm-up period, lanes 1 and 8 will be used for push pace work, lanes 2 and 7 for one-way dive sprints, and lanes 3, 4, 5 and 6 for general warm-up. ***During the last 20 minutes of warm-up in the competition pool on Saturday and Sunday, there will be one lane designated for 8 and under swimmers only.*** The 4 lanes in the warm-up course will be for general warm-up and swim down. No starting practice in that course. Warm-up procedures will be posted on deck and announced by the Deck and Starter Referees.

Eligibility: All swimmers must be currently registered with USA Swimming by noon on June 20th.

Entry Deadline: **On-line and team Hy-Tek/TeamUnify entries are due by 11:59 pm, Friday, June 14, 2024.** All entries received after the June 14, 2024, deadline are subject to a \$10.00 late fee. Relay entries are due on the day of the event at a time to be determined by the meet referee. Relay-only swimmers may enter on-line to pay the pool surcharge and are due by June 18, 2024. Late entries will be accepted until 12:00 noon on Wednesday June 19, 2024. **No deck entries will be accepted.**

Online Entries: All entries must be submitted electronically using Hy-Tek's Team Manager, TeamUnify or other team management software capable of generating zipped Cl2 entry files. **To submit Hy-Tek Team Manager or TeamUnify entries, send the entry file and Meet Entry Report as attachments to an email to rickklatt@gmail.com** Unattached swimmers affiliated with CCS may enter this meet on the CCS website, as long as the swimmer registered on the CCS site for their USA Swimming membership.

CCS Outreach swimmers who are entered in this meet will have their fees deducted by the Host Club. The Home Club or responsible individual of the Outreach Swimmer is responsible for communicating with the Host Team of their roster and fees that need to be deducted. Names of the athletes who are receiving the Outreach incentive may be kept confidential at the discretion of the athletes' Home Club.

Entry Fees: \$4.00 for each individual event, \$6.00 per relay. \$15.00 per CCS swimmer pool surcharge and \$25.00 per non-CCS swimmer pool surcharge. Full payment (single team check) for an email entry must be postmarked within 48 hours of the email entry (see address below). NO REFUNDS. RETURNED CHECKS WILL INCUR A SERVICE FEE. ENTRIES & FEES RECEIVED AFTER DUE DATE WILL INCURE A \$10 LATE FEE PER SWIMMER.
