One concern that surfaced was how to deal with a swimmer, volunteer, or official that failed to sign a waiver and still participated in the meet.

Administrative Chair Report – July 2020 Colorado Swimming BoD Meeting July 12, 2020

#### Covid Task Force -

After sharing the idea of holding a Task team to identify key issues and solutions for CSI during the Covid Virus process in the US. A Team of various CSI members worked together each Tuesday to identify and evaluate the challenges, work with various audiences and discussion solutions. The Task team crafted a letter to the CO Governor and selected County Health Agencies and commissioners. We worked with the ACES Lobbyist Initiative in support of their efforts to impact the Governor and their office's decisions to reopen Pools in the State. Advancements were made with the Governors office over the course of reopening and also with various county agencies throughout the state. We presented key initiatives to the CSI BoD and gained agreement to interview a Lobbyist for advancing CSI issues to reopening and maintenance of open status should a resurgence of the Virus were to return in the Fall and Winter of 2020. The Goal is to get Pools into their own categories, To work with School Districts and any others that influence our indoor facilities, and to expand capacity at all facilities so that competition can take place as soon as possible knowing we have the challenges of social distancing and maintenance of facilities and athlete health and safety.

The Interview committee completed identification of a Lobbying firm and the goals and strategies were discussed and implemented over the past three weeks. We secured a meeting with the Governor's team and met in the first week of working together. Engagements have also happened between the firm and other lobbyists for target groups (schools districts, CHSAA, and others.) Updates are given each week to the Covid Task Force and to the BoD when they meet. The CSI Executive Secretary is the key point of contact for all parties in this CSI Lobbying Initiative.

#### **USA Swimming Corporate Bylaw Updates -**

USA Swimming announced newly implemented Corporate Bylaw changes voted on April 24, 2020. These changes impact the following items;

- 1) **Effective immediately**, extends the requirement for non-athlete membership to individuals serving on the board of directors of any member club. (Bylaw 2.6.6)
- 2) **Effective January 1, 2021**, All clubs must have (i) at least one member coach, plus a Board of Directors or other governing body, or (ii) at least two member coaches to ensure that there are at least two adult authorities at each member club for communication and accountability purposes. (Bylaw 2.6.12)
- 3) **Effective immediately**, explicitly provides for electronic meetings and voting by the House of Delegates. (Bylaws 6.2.1 and 6.2.5)
- 4) **Effective September 26, 2020**, aligns athlete's representation on committees with USOPC Bylaws. (Bylaws 5.1 (D); 5.2; 5.3; 5.4.1; 5.5.1; 5.6.1; 5.7.1 (A))

In consultation with the USA Swimming Legal Department (Abby Howard) it was determined that since these changes are to the Corporate Bylaws of the Greater organization, then they are adopted as the date identified into the LSC Bylaws as well without the need to have a HoD vote for approval. The exact language of each of the above changes will be coming out from USA Swimming shortly and we can make the Bylaw changes to the CSI Bylaws accordingly with that new language.

#### Admin Vice Chair Job Description -

Completed a re-written job description for the Administrative Vice Chair role in CSI. This was submitted to the Governance Committee for their addition to the CDI Job Descriptions data set.

#### **Update to CSI P&P Document -**

At this meeting of the BoD, we will be moving to approve a new P&P document for CSI. This document has additions from the old CSI Bylaws document that were not moved into the new CSI Bylaw Template. The Bylaw committee identified these additions as a necessary update to the P&P document to retain key information about roles, definitions, and other key content that was important to retain in the operating documents of CSI, but were no longer allowed in the new Bylaws Template. These items are listed in "RED" in the P&P Document attached to the BOD Meeting.

This document also contains changes and additions that have been approved in CSI BoD meetings since the 2019 HOD meeting. These changes are also listed in "RED"

The Officials Section of the P&P document has several changes/additions to criteria. These were added at the request of the Officials Chair and the Officials Committee. These additions are in "**Red**" located in the Officials section of the document.

There were some items that existed in the P&P document already that better fit in new areas so that they correspond to the additional information that was added from the Old Bylaw template. No content was changed, just moved. This content is listed in "BLUE" letters for identification.

#### LSC Conference calls by USA Swimming -

USA Swimming sponsored LSC conference calls since the start of the Covid 19 shutdown of swimming. This group was designed to keep communication going for all LSC's along with identifying key issues needing to be addressed across the country while in the down time, but also to identify needs as it relates to competition and ultimately reopening. This was a weekly call for about two months and then it moved to a bi-weekly call. Many topics were discussed on these calls including updates to support for the LSC's, Changes in the calendar for competition, decisions regarding re-opening and support tools to assist LSC's work to re-open when the time is appropriate. The LSC GC, Admin Chair, and Executive Secretary all were involved in these conference calls.

As soon as the no transfer period is removed, I will transfer to Colorado Swimming's Google Domain and we will use coloradoswimming.org for the all-star zone page. That way we can easily give out that information and if people find the other site it is easy to get them back to swimcolorado.org.

MI Sports Fundraiser: Shirts have been ordered and delivered, we sold about 150.

BUDGET MEETING: Will be 7pm on August 12th, budget requests will be due to Jillian on Monday Aug 3rd.

<u>Virtual Swimposium:</u> Testing out Breakout rooms to be able to offer several small group discussions at the same time. We may want to look into adding another host to our account to allow for more than one meeting at a time. I believe it is about \$90ish per year. I will have to look up what we paid last year.

<u>In-person HOD</u>: We will be having, if all requirements of social distance remain at the levels they are now, an in-person HOD on Oct 4<sup>th</sup> at 9:00am at the Marriott Colorado Springs.

<u>Awards Banquet</u>: Idea to have all award recipients be invited to the 2021 banquet OR Have a virtual banquet for up to 100 people.

**Lobbyist Updates:** Most up to date information to be given at the meeting.

<u>Sanctioning:</u> USA Swimming published its new required items. In the required items is a sample of a liability statement. Ingrid adapted the statement (see below) and recommends that we also have a signed liability statement. I have updated all of our documents to reflect new guidelines.

We have taken enhanced health and safety measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19; however, we cannot guarantee that you will not be exposed to COVID-19. - Below is the list of weekly meetings I've been participating in. This increased amount of communication has been hugely beneficial to keep CSI at the forefront of the Covid-19 situation. They have also helped our LSC to be at the forefront of being proactive.
  - Tuesday's at 12:30pm- CSI Task Force Meeting
  - Thursday's at 9:00am- CSI Coaches Coffee Talk
  - Every other Thursday at 10:00am- USA Swimming/LSC Leadership Meeting
  - Plus regular meetings with other coaches from around CSI and other LSC leaders from around the country.
- As listed above, the CSI Covid-19 task force has continued to meet weekly, or as frequently as necessary, to
  discuss the current state of the situation in our LSC. Our focus has continued to be centered around increasing
  communication, creating solutions, assistance and pathways to getting back to our normal way of operating.
  One of our most recent tasks has been creating the direction and setting the expectations for our newly hired
  lobbying firm. The different perspectives and location of the task force members has been very valuable as we
  navigate through the current crisis.
- As discussed at our June 16th board meeting, the lobbyist interview sub-committee (Tristan Cross, Dale Ammon, Ingrid Bryant, Shawn Smith, Tom Byorick and Jackie Stiff) recommended the hiring of Nexus Policy Group to the CSI Board. So far they have been fantastic allies in our efforts to expand the competitive swimming opportunities within CSI.
  - Since our 6/16 board meeting, Nexus has been working extensively with Jackie to gather the information necessary to further our situation. We have also had two strategy meetings as a group; as well as a Zoom meeting with Adam Zarrin (policy advisor to Gov. Polis). Our meeting with Adam Zarrin was very positive. We were able to make significant progress towards advancing the competitive swimming opportunities for CSI and showing that CSI should be recognized as experts in aquatics operation in the state of Colorado. Additional documents on the safety and benefit of competitive swimming have been created and sent to Adam Zarrin to present to Gov. Polis; along with all of the relevant documents from USA Swimming.
- Below are the general objectives we have passed along to Kayla Tibbals and Patrick Boyle, partners at Nexus Policy Group. These objectives may evolve or change as progress is made throughout the Covid-19 crisis.
  - Nexus Policy Group Objectives:
    - 1. Get State policy to reflect Larimer County and Douglas County variances.
      - 1. Initial focus on 1 person per 28 sq ft metric.
      - 2. Recognize square footage in indoor pool capacity calculation.
    - 2. Get indoor pools separated from gyms, yoga studios, etc. in the Public Health Order.
    - 3. Get Colorado school districts actively engaged in the discussion of re-opening pools and understanding the safety and overall benefit of competitive swimming. This is crucial as outdoor pools begin closing in the fall.
- Board Meeting Dates for 2020:
  - We will continue to hold periodic emergency CSI board meetings in response to any developments or announcements regarding the current Covid-19 situation. Please be on the lookout for these meeting announcements.
  - September 12th
  - September 24-26th— USAS Convention- Will be held remotely

#### Safe Sport Chair Board Report

#### **Past/Current Activities:**

The June, 2020 Safe Sport Recognition Program (SSRP) statistics from USA Swimming Safe Sport show that Colorado Swimming has 81 registered clubs. 26 of our clubs had started the work to become Safe Sport Recognition certified. 12 of them have now achieved that goal:

\*Clubs that need a Safe Sport Presentation/education opportunity prior to submission; or clubs that need another presentation since their last one was more than 1 year ago (FST).

DSA (8/4/2019) and GTS (8/28/2019) have been notified that they will need another Safe Sport Presentation if they do not file before their previous presentation date. CAC Boulder Riptide is working on getting their Safe Sport presentation set up. Montrose Marlins has recently requested the files to get started on becoming Safe Sport Recognition certified.

We started out Number One in the LSC rankings when statistics were first published; we are now 12th among all the LSC's. In the Western Zone, Sierra Nevada (16), Oregon (15), and Utah (14) are now ahead of us.

All our clubs have been notified that Safe Sport Presentations can be accomplished in a variety of ways; whatever suits their club best given the COVID-19 requirements. One can be held outdoors with plenty of social distancing, or indoors in a room big enough to provide that same distancing. If done in conjunction with the finish time of different practice groups, it can be held for each practice group to keep the audience smaller. It can be accomplished on Zoom.

Information has been passed on to all our clubs regarding the following: USA Swimming is providing the opportunity in a monthly drawing for its SSRP member clubs to win a chance for a National Team member or alum to visit their club free of charge. It is being sponsored by the Keeping Athletes First Action Plan.

Coaches and athletes are looking forward to getting back to competition. The uncertainty of the upcoming competition schedule continues to be quite stressful.

High School seniors are having an unusually difficult time with the recruiting process. There is a fear that some college coaches may be dishonest about university finances and program stability.

Clubs are worried about new membership in the fall. With neither a high school boys' season nor a summer club season the USA Swimming market is nearly impossible to wrangle. How can CSI help market and advertise USA club swimming?

#### **ACTION ITEM:**

Does CSI want to create a Facebook page and commit \$2,800 in target ads in an attempt to reach 10,000 people? The ad would effectively be a direct link to the CSI Club Portal.

Team administrators and coaches would be notified and encouraged to update their website appropriately.

No CSI team(s) would be highlighted or mentioned.

The committed money would be designated as COVID response.

One new team member equates to \$1,500 - \$3,000 per year for a club team.

I am currently working with Vinny to see if we have VMAC reserved on specific dates for the 2022 Zone 2 LC Age Group meet. If not, I will be reaching out to the Zone 2 coaches to get a consensus on the dates for the 2022 LC Zone 2 meets. It is also my recommendation that, due to the absence of the Zone 2 meets this year, host rotations get pushed back a year for the Age Group meets. That would mean that the 2021 Age Group meet would be hosted by ACES, the 2022 Age Group meet would be hosted by STARS, and the 2023 Age Group meet would be hosted by FST. The Senior meet for all 3 years would be hosted by TOPS.
