



Activity at Time of Injury





Where Accident Occurred





Body Part Injured





DATE: SEPTEMBER 01, 2021

The effects of COVID-19 continue to impact CSI and clubs with no or limited competitive events – inter squad or outdoor meets and in water practices being conducted through February 2021. Indoor & outdoor pools were allowed to open in mid-June 2020 under strict limits and guidelines on facility capacity, health checks, conducting swim practices and competitive events.

During the two-month period ending 8/31/21 there have been six accidents reported and filed with USA Swimming. Summary of accidents by type across USA Swimming for the quarter ended 6/30/21 is attached for your review.

The following accidents for our LSC are:

Competition – athlete kicked on the top of the head by another swimmer, removed from the meet, evaluated for a concussion in the ER

Competition – athlete - cut bottom of foot

Competition – coach - existing condition neuropathy – lost feeling legs

Competition – athlete – intense right quadrant abdominal pain, shortness of breath, no chest pain – hyperventilation

Competition – athlete struck top & back of head against wall of pool, evaluated for a concussion, determined by a nurse & physician at the pool to have a mild concussion

Competition – athlete stepped up onto the block, kicked it resulting in the loss of the toe nail – second toe

Competition – athlete struck baby toe on the side of the pool resulting in a laceration on the toe

Disability Report, July 2021

Char Sorensen, Disability Chair

Old Business:

Colorado hosted Move United Junior Nationals at VMAC on Monday July 19 (Long Course) and Tuesday July 20 (Short Course) 2021. It was a tremendous success with swimmers coming from all over the country. We had 520 splashes over the two-day meet. Records were set in many events and at least 5 athletes are pursuing Paralympics Classification to compete at USPara meets.

The following states brought 1 swimmer each

Arizona, Kentucky, Ohio, Wisconsin, Kansas, Delaware

Minnesota brought 2 teams, one with 2 swimmers and the other had 6 swimmers.

Florida and Georgia each had 2 swimmers,

Alabama and Missouri each had 5 swimmers

Pennsylvania had 8 swimmers,

Illinois, New Jersey each brought 10 swimmers and Texas brought 15 swimmers

There were another 30 swimmers who came independently to swim at the championship meet since they made qualifying times in their home state and did not have a team to attach with.

Colorado had 3 swimmers, Gracie Oswald, Dillon Mezey and Jack Williamson, and each performed fabulously.

Jack Williamson read the Athlete's Oath and Char Sorensen read the Officials Oath at the Welcoming Ceremony.

It is disappointing that only 3 of out of over 115 self-identified swimmers with a disability in our state competed at this meet.

The meet will be in Colorado again next year, and it is with great hope and encouragement that our clubs, coaches, parents, and swimmers are motivated to attend this terrific meet. Move United is a program that supports athletes with impairments across the board in all sports and helps move them into Paralympics if they are motivated and can meet the challenges.

We also had the following officials work this meet: Doug Everett, David Brown, Jim Shumate, Alice Coffman, Laurie Black, Linda Eaton, Candace Stone, Febi Yuwono, Anne Lawley, Pam Gerecht, Wayne Sherman, and Char Sorensen.
