Unfinished (Old) Business:

- 1. Update on Commerce City Pool Kelly Leid, Exec.VP of Oakwood Homes Co., presented updates of the Reunion Center development project in the Commerce City area. Kelly is asking CSI to take a leadership role in the planning for the Water House (pool) component, with possible financial buy-in and equity sharing as this portion of the project progresses. Conversation ensued within CSI after the presentation concluded.
 - A motion was made for the CSI Executive Committee to develop a job description, compensation package, and communication requirements for an individual representing CSI to take the role of advisor for the Water House project. The Executive Board will bring this proposal to the BOD at our May BOD meeting. M/S/P
- 2. ByLaws and Policy&Procedures Update A subcommittee has been formed to attend to these important projects for CSI. Robert Scandary volunteered to assist in these projects. Updates will be presented at the May BOD meeting.
- 3. LEAP P&P Changes (tabled from Dec. BOD meeting) Information respective of this will be brought forward at the May BOD meeting.

Action Items:

- 1. Tristin Cross presented information with regard to the previous All Star meets. Colorado has dominated these meets for the past several years and believes that a more competitive meet would be more beneficial for our swimmers. Conversation among board members was shared, and ultimately Tristin had requested assistance in seeking a more competitive meet in addition to him looking for other meet opportunities himself. The results of these pursuits will be reported at the May BOD meeting. No other action requested.
- 2. Robert Scandary requested reimbursement for the costs of a ream of paper and a printer cartridge for BOD business. M/S/P
- 3. Mike Dilli asked for any interested CSI athletes to apply for a position on the Officials Committee. The application is attached to his report. No other action requested.
- 4. Linda Eaton asked for the opportunity to have a session at Swimposium for Kid Power, a presentation on empowering our athletes to better deal with bullying. No other action requested.

New Business:

- 1. Shawn Smith requested permission to submit a bid to co-host the 2021 Four Corners Sectional Meet. CSI would partner with Jenks, OK, in bidding for this meet. Conversation among members ensued, with a motion being made to permit this bid. M/S/P
- 2. Mike Dilli presented concerns related to the continuing problem of late entries for meets. A number of members entered into this conversation and presented a variety of possible solutions to remedy this time consuming issue. Ultimately, a motion was made to include the following (or similar) language into CSI sponsored meet information documents:M/S/P
 - "A \$200.00 team fine will be levied for each late entry swimmer that occurs after the deadline* for psych sheet review until Sunday, at 11:59pm current Mountain Time. After that time (Sunday @ 11:59pm MT) no further entries will be accepted. (* defined as 48 hours from the timestamp on the email that includes the psych sheets)"

Safe Sport Chair Board Report

Past Activities:

January/February: Teams who have had Safe Sport presentations given by the LSC Safe Sport Chair: Falfins and Foothills. Met with Altitude Performance coaches to outline the work needed to become a Safe Sport Recognition Club.

Dale Ammon and I met with Eric Stefanski to discuss strategies for building better relationships with teams in his area and how to minimize the strain between friends when teammates of long standing split due to changing teams.

Attended the USA Swimming Safe Sport Leadership Conference. Was impressed with the work Kidpower of Colorado has been doing to help kids handle difficult situations in the area of Safe Sport. Discussed the possibility of a workshop for our LSC athletes at Swimposium with the Admin Vice Chair.

On-going Activity: Continue to schedule meetings with LSC clubs/teams to review their Safe Sport policies and procedures; provide club specific PDF templates for assisting them in obtaining Safe Sport Recognition Club status. Provide a Safe Sport table at key geographically placed LSC meets (2019 CUDA/STAR meet already on the list). Handle Safe Sport issues as they arise.

Action Item: Request Board approval for adding a workshop at Swimposium for a presentation by Kidpower of Colorado.

Administration Vice Chair Report Colorado Swimming BOD March 2, 2019

The Western Zone announced this week that the event format for the 2019 Western Zone Age Group Championship for 2019 will not include 10&U 400M relays as was decided in in the WZ Business meeting and approved by HOD. One additional change is that the decision to include 10&U 200 mixed will not occur as well since this was an out of order decision of the HOD. The 2019 meet will go with only 200M relays for 10&U and future input will be considered at the Business-meeting associated with the 2019 Meet.

It was announced that Colorado's own, Kathleen Scandary, was named the USA Swimming National Officials Chair. Congratulations to Kathleen!

Meetings attended since last CSI BOD meeting (In support of USA Swimming and WZ Director Role)...

USA Swimming Safe Sport Conference – This was an outstanding conference that shared a number of situations and potential resolutions through working with the USA Swimming Safe Sport team as well as some outside community organizations with very impactful situational leadership training opportunities as well as Team oriented leadership training sessions for the betterment of a Safe Sport environment within the LSC and Team level.

USA Swimming BOD Meeting – Colorado Springs 2/2/19 – The USA BoD continues their movement to a Strategic Governance based Board of Directors. The new governance model continues to be implemented by the Board. Operations of the USA-S organization are currently migrating to Staff and Key committees outside of the Board.

USMS BOD Meeting – Tampa, FL - I attended the USMS BoD Winter meeting as the Alliance Representative of the USA-S BoD to the USMS Board. Kay issues that are worth considering collaborative work with USMS may be Open Water Swimming.

2019 Catch the Spirit Camp:

2019 Western Zone Age Group Championship:

- This year's Western Zone Age Group Championship will be held in Mt. Hood, OR. Based on the timing and location of this meet, the cost per athlete will be more than it was in 2017 and 2018. We are currently working to create the most economical trip possible for the Team Colorado athletes. More information about the logistics will be sent out in the near future.
- The 2019 Time Standards, including the Colorado Standards, will be posted to the CSI website in April 2019.
- The Colorado Zone Team selection criteria will be posted to the CSI website along with the qual times.
- The coaches and chaperone applications will be sent out in mid-April.
 - These items will be sent out to all CSI team contacts.

Athlete Representative for CSI Officials Committee

The CSI Officials committee is comprised of one official from each of the five zones in Colorado, plus one seasonal official representative and an Officials Coordinator, and an athlete representative. The committee meets 3-4 times per year (usually at a CSI sponsored meet or via a group phone call). They discuss CSI sponsored meets, recruitment and training of officials in the LSC and any other issues that may be affecting officiating in the state. An athlete representative provides needed athlete input to the committee concerning officiating in CSI.

To be eligible to serve as the athlete rep for the CSI Officials Committee, the applicant should write a short letter of interest which details their swim background and why they would like to serve the swimmers of Colorado, on the Officials Committee. Applicants must be an athlete on a swim club in the LSC and be in high school. Applicants must be willing to communicate via email with other committee members, serve on occasional subcommittees and be willing to attend 3-4 meetings (phone or in person) per year.
