Report of Officers/Committees

General Chair-No written report, thanked everyone for letting him serve. Vice Chair-No written report, two scoreboards have been purchased for IES Senior Vice Chair- Written report attached, reminded all to encourage swimmers to get scholarship applications in by July. Update on Olympic Trials fund. Taylor McCoy, Daniel Roy and Sarah Nicholls all qualified for Olympic Trials. With their respective coaches the reimbursement allocation is \$10,500. Only \$7,500 in that fund so the remaining \$3000 will be taken from savings.

<u>Treasurer</u>-Written Statement of Revenue and Expenses dated 03/31/2016 and 2016 Fiscal Year Investment Activity reports were distributed. The written reports are attached. Rev/

Exp report is on a cash basis, the scoreboards were purchased in April for \$6400 and therefore do not show on this report. IES Checking has \$165,000 balance earning 0% interest so some of those funds will be moved to investment accounts.

Athlete Representatives-No report

Officials Chairman-Had a meeting this morning prior to HOD, went well. Need each team to designate an Officials Contact and get that information to Terri.

Safety Chairman- Need more members on this committee, each team needs to have a Safety Contact.

<u>Safe Sport Chairman-</u>Liz Law is taking this position and is going to training next week. USA Swimming is pushing to have a Safe Sport Contact on each team.

Sanctions Chairman-Computer crash this spring delayed some meet sanctions, but now up to date.

<u>Records Chairman</u>-There have already been new IES records set this year, but will not be official until Aug 31.

Unfinished (old) Business

Change of Fiscal Year-Update from Dan Hougardy-Cash basis creates timing issues for our financial reports with a lot of the revenues and expenses centered around Sept 30, which is why we are looking to change fiscal year end to Dec 31. Dan is meeting with a CPA April 20. Request to IRS will be for a FYE September 2016, Oct 1 -Dec 31, 2016 will be a separate period, then 2017 will be a Jan - Dec period. IES will have budgets for the short period and Oct - Dec 2016 and the full year of 2017. These budgets will be presented at the Fall HOD meeting.

Election of Officers

Elections were held and the following positions were selected. General Chairman - John Pringle Secretary - Pam Wilson Senior Chairman - Michael Woodward

Finance Chair position will be elected at the fall HOD. John Pringle's current position will be vacated and someone else will be appointed to his position once John takes office in the fall.

John commented that the Coaches recommended CAST be awarded the meet. MRA offered to host the meet if CAST was unable to for any reason.

A motion was made and seconded to Award GMSC the 2017 Short Course Championship meet to be held at the University of Idaho pool. Motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made and seconded to Award PSA the 2017 Long Course Championship meet to be held at the Pendleton pool.

Motion passed with all in favor except one.

Discussion regarding the need for teams that are new to hosting champs meet get experience this year shadowing experienced teams that are hosting the 2016 champs meets.

A motion was made and seconded to accept the revised 2017 Meet Calendar. Motion passed unanimously.

IES Age Group Vice Chair Report: Spring 2016

Reminders from Convention 2015

2016 Marketing Kits will be available soon. There will be two kits available: a marketing kit and a retention kit. I highly recommend that all clubs check out www.usaswimming.org/swimtoday for more information on ordering kits. These are an essential tool and will help maximize the enthusiasm that the 2016 Rio Olympics will generate for swimming.

A reminder of the two potential rule changes that will be coming up:

1) Tech suit ban for 14 and under swimmers at all age group defined competition; 14 and under swimmers would be allowed to wear tech suits in open/senior competition. If the coaches in the room have their way, it will be a comprehensive ban that would essentially eliminate any suit other than your basic, vanilla racing suit. There was a lot of enthusiasm for this potential ban, but there are a lot of parties that need to come together to make this happen. Discussions will likely go on during the course of the year, with potential legislation being voted on at the 2016 USA Swimming HOD.

If you have strong opinions about this potential legislation (mainly, a reason to NOT support it), please let me know so that I can submit it on your behalf to USA Swimming.

2) A late rule change was submitted (and defeated because it was submitted late, and required 90% to pass) to change max races from 5 per day to 6 per day. This will likely be submitted again earlier in the calendar year (therefore not requiring a 90% vote but a simple majority). I think it would be in our best interest as an LSC to formulate an opinion on this matter. I tend to see more pros than cons, but there are some potential opportunities for abuse. At any rate, this is something I may be discussing with you during the course of the year, assuming that the legislation is proposed again.

This rule directly impacts Inland Empire. I am in favor of such a change in that it could have a positive impact on our meet structure and operations. Again, if you have a strong opinion on this potential legislation, please let me know.

Finally, please encourage all athletes and parents to participate in the short SafeSport Training webinar that is available at USA Swimming website. It is free for athletes and parents. Here are the web addresses:

Coaches Representative Report Spring 2016 Bob Wood

Only few items have been brought to my attention this time around:

- Poor Air Quality has had less of an impact than previous years due to not hosting meets at EWU and improvement of air quality at Central, and the improvement of air quality at Federal Way due to the retro-fit of the HVAC system there.
- 2. At the National Level of USAS there is still discussion about how to better serve the LSCs with under 2500 swimming members. Part of the discussion includes clumping smaller LSC's like ours into larger LSCs, as I have been warning for the last several years. Due to the Olympic Cycle nothing will be done in this calendar year but we must be aware that this subject will come up the following year.
- 3. A relaxation of restrictions at the Kroc Center may allow CAST to host up to two meets a year at the facility, which is good news from a facilities standpoint and may slightly offset the loss of EWU as a meet hosting site on the East side of the LSC.
- 4. I would like to solicit for some ideas on how the coach's representative can better serve the smaller teams in the LSC. If anyone has any ideas please let me know. I frankly feel as if I am doing next to nothing serving the coaches in the LSC so I would be grateful for any ideas any of you may have to better serve you all.

The long course season will be starting soon, here are some early reminders:

- Make sure your swimmer hydrate properly, that means they need to start drinking water the night before, drink on a regular basis not only when thirsty
- Swimmers need to be well rested
- Eat a balance diet
- Avoid diuretics: soft drinks, teas, coffee and energy drinks
- No running on deck
- No standing on chairs/tables
- No horse play on deck
- Feet first entry into the water during practice and at meets during warm-ups

Safe Sport Chair Report April, 2016 Corrine Dutto

No Safe Sport Incidents have been reported to me in IES since the last report October, 2015.

SWIM STAFF SELECT is now up and running. SWIM STAFF SELECT (www.swimstaffselect.org) is a Webbased cloud application (app) that helps you screen applicants for staff and volunteer positions at your swim club. Using Swim Staff Select, you can create position descriptions, job postings, job applications, reference checking scripts, and interview scripts. You can also communicate with applicants and review applications.

Teams, Coaches, Officials and Parents can go to "fill my club's tool kit" for LOTS of information, including:

- Model Policies and Guidelines
- Tips for Parents
- Safe Sport Introduction for Parents-Power Point presentation USAS teams may use to introduce new families to Safe Sport. This would be great for new family orientation. It shows how your team and USAS is committed to keeping all of our swimmers safe.
- Pre-season parent orientation handout
- Safe sport overview for coaches
- For Meet Directors, Admin Officials, Referees and other officials: Safe Sport Guide for Meet Administration, Pre-Meet Safe Sport Risk Assessment and Safe Sport Scenarios at Meets. This will help to plan for a safe meet, identify problems, and address those problems at swim meets.
- Heat sheet ads
- No cameras sign
- No deck changing poster
- Resource guide for peer-on –peer incidents
- Pre-season parent orientation handout

Coaches: Please remind your swimmers to change in designated areas (locker rooms). No deck changing at meets or at practices.
