



OUTREACH MEMBERSHIPS - What YOU Can Do Right Now!!

The USA Swimming Corporate Bylaws (Article 2.4.2C) define Outreach membership as a "Premium membership with specially reduced fees. Each LSC House of Delegates shall determine how athletes qualify for Outreach membership."

Inland Empire Swimming House of Delegates has determined that *Outreach membership will be made available to club members at the discretion of each individual club, per individual club policies*. This Outreach membership is available through the Club Registrar and/or the Club Administrator, to be distributed to designated individuals. *There is no steadfast rule for how an Outreach Membership is to be determined by each club and documentation is not required regarding the club's decision to make Outreach available to designated members.*

Financial Hardship does not only include low-income situations. Unexpected financial hardship, whether temporary or long-term (such as family illness) can also be a significant barrier to inclusion in our sport and is often a major factor in the LOSS of athletes from our sport.

The IES Board of Directors has tasked the IES DEI Committee to begin development of possible resources (grants, scholarships, etc) that could be made available to IES athletes independently of individual club resources. Clubs are also highly encouraged to consider what options they have available to decrease financial barriers to inclusion in our sport in their community.
