IES is truly leading the way. We are being creative in supporting our membership with a small LSC with a large geography that covers portions of three states. This creativity brought us

- A shared Swimposium.
- A shared athlete experience at the USA-S Zone workshop.
- Co-hosting of a few large swim meets both at LSC and club level.

This shows that through creative programs and ideas, IES will continue to develop, improve and support competitive Swimming in the Inland.

Highlights:

- We reformated our two Short-Course Meets to better meet the needs of athletes of Inland Empire Swimming.
- We changed the funding and financial support for the three IES Championship Meets to better support hosting clubs.
- We have a full Board of Directors with the addition of Carolyn Peterson as Administrative Vice Chair and Ben Galligan as Operational Risk Chair.
- The LSC supported and sent April Walkey and Jeff Sutton to the 2022 Mighty 2500 Workshop hosted by USA-Swimming.
- We successfully partnered with Snake River Swimming to host 2nd Swimposium, with this occurring in Spokane.
- Our LSC sent athletes, coaches, and officials to many meets above the LSC Championship level and have had great success.
- Provide additional support for SC SR Zones meet for officials as this meet is still in trial and not supported by Western Zones Offical's funds.
- Developed and formed an athlete committee by the leadership of our Jr and Sr Reps.
