6:30 pm Meeting called to order by Keith Lambert:

General Chair Lambert thanked everyone for attending and stated that the House of Delegates meeting is normally run by the Administrative Vice Chair, Jeff Sutton, and so Keith turned the meeting over to Jeff.

• General Chair Report: Keith Lambert

The State of IES is strong. The numbers of registered athletes is strong, the attendance at meets has rebounded. The board works together well reaching goals while steering with both vison and prudence. Keith had extra praise for Jody Broyles for her ability to engage effectively with all levels of swimming and all facets of the organization from LSC to Western Zones and up on the national administration. Jody has a wide swim bag of skills

- Financial Report: Don Hougardy
 - The financial state of IES remains strong and as the board had been conservative with the budget during the Covid period categories were not depleted. And the funds from splash fees came in larger than anticipated for Covid restricted months.
 - Unused funds from the Olympic Trial account will be transferred in to the general fund totaling \$6,443.
 - o Don Hougardy reviewed the Western Age Group Zones meet that was hosted by IES and netted \$20,116 for the LSC. Thanks to the hard work from Jody Broyles and others for pulling that together in a distant Texas location.
 - The Investment side of the accounts showed increases in the Income fund of 19.79% for 2021 and in the balanced fund growth of 22%. Don reminded us all that so far in 2022 the investment returns have not been as robust.
- Safe Sport: April Walkley
 - April reported that ten clubs are SafeSport recognized and that four are continuing to work through the requirements. April remains wonderfully helpful and positive about working with clubs to achieve their goals and to have all athletes, parents and coaches SafeSport secure.

Pulled for Discussion:

- Membership/Registration/Times: Jody Broyles
 - Jody reported that there were 1150 year-round athletes registered as of 5/22 and that last year at this point there were 1024 and there is still the summer season to add more swimmers. This is exciting growth for the LSC.
 - Registration: USA Swimming is bringing forth online registration for swimmers.
 Jody reported that the Swim Club is the gateway, so that each swimmer will need to
 register with a club and then the club provides them with a one-time code and link
 to USA Swimming. They register there and pay directly. USA swimming then is
 able to link them back to their club.
 - The IES office is then notified of the registration and the LSC approves the transaction. Then IES will receive their portion of funds.

Committees and Special Reports:

• Western Zones 2023 Open Water Meet- CAST Jade Sobek

Jade reported that August 26, 2023 the Western Zones Open Water Swim Meet will take place in Lake Coeur D'Alene, Idaho as hosted by CAST and IES. This is an exciting opportunity for area swimmers. There are also several Open Water events this year culminating with the Western Zones competition on September 10th in Las Vegas NV.

- Championship Meet format: Jeff Sutton
 - Jeff discussed the fact that the are three Championship meets: Junior Championships, Short Course Junior Olympics, Long Course Junior Olympics. IN the past IES has provided the host team a stipend of \$4,500 to cover/defray facility costs. However, as that rental has soared teams are at a higher risk for hosting these large meets.
 - o The IES board wanted to see how the LSC could improve the quality of these meets for the swimmers, the clubs, the officials, and in general the entire experience. A committee was formed and came back with the recommendation that the LSC should take on the facility cost and purchasing awards and administrative support. More details will be finalized by the fall.
- **LEAP Update** Jody Broyles **LSC E**valuation **A**chievement **P**rogram with3 levels of Achievement
 - $\circ~$ IES worked hard and successfully passed level II.- Hats off to all folks who made that happen. Covered till 2024
 - o Jody walked the group through the revamped website and all the new information available thanks to the long hard work of many. Check out the IES website and the new tabs and links. From Policies to DEI to events and coaches training. Something for everyone.
- Swimposium: Jeff Sutton
 - Jeff reported on the success of the jointly held Swimposium with Snake River swimming held in Boise in April 2022. The feedback has been super positive from all sides and USA swimming is considering supporting another one in 2023.
- Special Reports: USA Business Meeting update, Keith Lambert
 - Keith reported that the LSC sent Keith Lambert, Sean Muncie, Jade Sobek, Russ Whitaker, April Walkley, Chamelle Abringe, Jody Broyles
 - Western Zone Workshop Jody Broyles- plenty of new information and it is important that IES has a strong presence at these meetings.
