# **General Duties and Expectations**

- 2. Be active, enthusiastic and energetic.
- 3. Inspire and motivate all swimmers to train and compete to the best of their ability.
- 4. Provide positive feedback and encouragement to all swimmers. Strive to make positive contact with each swimmer each practice.
- 5. Focus on personal improvement of each swimmer.
- 6. Be prepared to get in the water when necessary to demonstrate skills or work hands-on with swimmers.
- 7. Ensure the safety of the swimmer and take action to avoid potential hazards and unsafe conditions and activities.
- 8. Ensure compliance with safety rules at practices and meets.
- 9. Report all safety issues to the Head Coach or Facility Management.
- 10. Assist with emergency situations in accordance with the facility's Emergency Action Plan.
- 11. Report all accidents and injuries to the Head Coach.
- 12. Regular, punctual, reliable practice attendance.
