Rules and Requirements

- Current USA Swimming and OSI Rules will be enforced. *Exceptions are noted on the Positive Check-In Schedule on page 5.*
- All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to
 the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (MAAPP), and that they
 understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this
 competition.
- OSI safety guidelines and warm-up procedures will be strictly enforced.
- Medical services available: Facility staff and lifeguards on duty, access to first responders via 911.
- No Technical Suit may be worn by any 12 & Under USA Swimming athlete member in competition at any Sanctioned, Approved or Observed meet.
- Unaccompanied athletes must be assigned a certified coach. Please contact the Meet Director for assistance.
- Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being
 proficient in performing racing starts or must start each race from within the water without the use of the
 backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or
 the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
- All club or individual members entering OSI Championship meets must be in good standing with no
 outstanding money owed to Oregon Swimming. All payments must be made prior to the meet entry
 deadline. Any club or member not in good standing may be denied entry into the meet.

Facility

Pools:

- Indoor 50 meter pool with 25 yard competition course in deep end; eight 7-ft. wide lanes; 13 ft. to 6 ft. deep with bulkhead at turn end. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4).
- Shallow end of indoor pool and outdoor six lane 25 meter pool will be available for warm-up/cool-down.
- Equipment:
 - Daktronics timing system with automatic touchpads and buttons and alpha-numeric scoreboard.
 - Colorado Championship starting system
 - Kiefer Custom Freestyle/Olympian starting blocks, with grab rails, foot chocks, and non-skid platforms.

Access:

- Facility opens at **2:30 pm Thursday and 7:00 am Friday through Sunday**. No spectator or athlete entrance to locker rooms, deck, or balcony before that time.
- All coaches (with participating athletes), officials, and any other person required by sanction to be a
 member of USA Swimming must visibly display their valid membership credentials at all times.
 Coaches must show current credentials to the Meet Director or designated volunteer upon arrival to the
 meet. Only athletes, credentialed coaches, officials, authorized volunteers, and facility employees are
 allowed in the competition area and behind the blocks.
- Facility is accessible to adaptive swimmers.

Seating:

- Spectator seating is limited to authorized areas only. Please observe facility signage for details. Chairs may be left overnight folded up against the wall to allow for cleaning of the deck. All other personal items must be removed from the facility at the end of each finals session.
- Folding chairs will not be allowed in the walkway areas within 10 feet of the pool to allow for adequate access around the pool.
- Disabled seating is available; contact Meet Director for details.





Parking:

- Please observe posted all no-parking signs, including in the shared middle school and Boys and Girls Club parking lots.
- No RV parking is allowed in the parking lots near the pool. Day use only RV parking is available around
 the city park located two blocks southwest of Osborn. No overnight camping allowed in the parking lots
 or neighborhoods. Camping is available at the Benton County Fairgrounds and at the Albany/Corvallis
 KOA.

Other:

- Concession items will be available throughout the meet.
- Live streaming may be available; information will be posted on oregonswimming.org and corvallisaquaticteam.org.

Restrictions

- Alcoholic beverages, tobacco products of any kind, and glass containers are not allowed in the swimming venue, on the grounds, or in the parking area.
- There is no body shaving allowed in the swimming venue.
- Use of audio or visual recording devices including cell phones is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms, and locker rooms. Photography is not allowed behind the blocks. Flash photography is not allowed except by express permission of the Meet Referee. Private use of underwater video recording devices in the competition pool is prohibited.
- Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas and open-ceiling locker rooms) any time coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
- Deck changes are prohibited.

Eligibility

- Athletes must be currently registered with USA Swimming/Oregon Swimming. No on deck registration.
- Age on the first day of competition applies to the entire meet.
- Qualifying times must be achieved from February 1, 2022 through the entry deadline for this meet.
- Athletes who have not achieved the qualifying time may also be eligible after receiving an "invitation to Compete" from Oregon Swimming.
- If the qualifying time in an event is not achieved by the athlete at the meet, and proof of a qualifying time is not in the USA SWIMS database, appropriate proof of the qualifying time must be forwarded to the OSI office within 10 days after notification from the office. Failure to prove a qualifying time will result in a \$100 non-qualifying fine from OSI. Athletes who have received an "Invitation to Compete" are not subject to the non-qualifying fine.

General Information

Format:

- All individual events 400 yards or longer and all relays are timed finals events.
- All individual events 200 yards or shorter are prelims/finals events. There will be one championship final in each age group/event.
- Preliminary heats are conducted by age group and event, slowest to fastest, unless noted below.
- The 1650 free is conducted all ages combined, fastest to slowest, alternating girls and boys.
- Preliminaries of the 500 Free and 400 IM are conducted all ages combined, fastest to slowest, with the fastest seeded heat of each age group in finals.
- The 1000 free is conducted all ages combined, fastest to slowest, alternating girls and boys, with the fastest seeded heat in finals.





Age Groups:

- 200 Butterfly, 200 Back, 200 Breast, 400 IM, 1000 free, 1650 free: 11-13, 14
- All other individual event finals; 11, 12, 13, 14

Entry Information

Limits:

- Athletes may enter six individual and five relay events for the meet; but not more than three individual events and two relays per day.
- Time trials count toward the three per day limit, but not toward the six per meet limit.

Deadlines & Process:

- The team Manager event file will be available on the Oregon Swimming website by January 16, 2023.
- Team Manager entry files and a pdf report of entries must be submitted via email to <u>SC11-14Entries@oregonswimming.org</u> by noon on Wednesday, February 15, 2023. OSI will confirm receipt of entries by replying with a team entry report and an entry fee report.
- Teams are encouraged to ensure the accuracy of their entries prior to submitting the initial file. In the event that any changes are needed to the initial entries, they must be emailed to the entry address by the above deadline. No late entries or changes will be accepted.
- New qualifying entries achieved between February 15 and February 19 must be submitted by sending an email to <u>SC11-14Entries@oregonswimming.org</u> by noon on Monday, February 20, 2023. The email should include the swimmer's name, USA Swimming ID#, event, and entry time. *Previously* entered times may not be updated.
- Coaches of athletes who have not achieved the qualifying time and instead receive an OSI "Invitation to Compete", will be notified via email by 3 pm on Monday, February 20, 2023. Invitation acceptances must be returned to OSI no later than noon on Tuesday, February 21, 2023.
- Entry times may be submitted in SCY, SCM, LCM. Converted times are not accepted.
- Entry fees are charged directly to the club's OSI account. No payment will be accepted at the pool.
- Questions regarding entries may be emailed to debbie@oregonswimming.org.
- Athletes with disabilities are encouraged to enter the meet. Accommodation requests should be directed to the Meet Referee.

Relays:

- Relay-Only athletes must be entered in the meet and pay all applicable fees.
- Aggregate times may be used for relay entries.

Fees \$15.00 surcharge per athlete \$4.00 per individual event entry fee

\$14.00 facility use fee per athlete \$10.00 per relay entry fee

\$5.00 electronic heat sheet fee per athlete

Check-in

Individual Events:

- Individual events 200 yards and shorter are pre-seeded and do not require check-in.
- Individual events 400 yards and longer are deck seeded and require positive check-in by the coach/athlete before the check-in deadline.
- Athletes are allowed to withdraw from events that require positive check-in with a Declared False Start (DFS) after the check-in deadline.
- Penalty Any athlete who fails to compete in an individual prelims event for which positive check-in
 was provided is barred from participation in further individual and relay events that day. Additionally,
 that swimmer shall not be seeded in any individual events on succeeding days unless that swimmer
 declares an intent to swim with the Admin Referee prior to the check in deadline for that day.





Relay Events:

- Positive check-in is required for all relays. If relays do not check in, they will be scratched and NOT permitted to compete in the event.
- Coaches will be provided with a relay check-in report to make additions or changes to athlete names prior to seeding. Please return to admin prior to the positive check-in deadline.
- Post seeding relay name changes must be notated on the lane timer sheet, before commencement of the heat.

Finals Qualifiers

Scratch Procedure:

- Any athlete qualifying for finals can scratch or declare their *intent* to scratch, within 30 minutes of the qualifiers announcement.
 - Athletes who have declared an *intent to scratch* have 30 minutes after the announcement of qualifiers for their last individual preliminary event, to codify the scratch with admin.
 - Athletes who do not scratch will be seeded into finals.
- Penalty Any athlete who fails to compete in a final event for which they have been seeded, is barred from
 participation for the remainder of the meet. For finals events on Sunday, the athlete's club will also be
 subject to a \$100 fine payable to OSI.

Time Trials

Sanction #:23-013

Referee: Matthew Beasley

- Fee per entry: \$10 per individual event, \$20 per relay event
- Time permitting, time trials will be conducted between prelims and finals. Entries will be accepted in the morning of that day's time trials.
- Time trials count toward the three events per day individual event entry limit, but not the six events per meet entry limit.
- Time trial participants must be entered in the meet in individual events or as relay-only athletes.
- Time trial participants must provide their own timers.
- Relay only athletes are eligible to compete in any time trials session.

Awards Scoring

Individual: 1st place patch (limited to one per athlete) and medal, Individual events: 9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1

2nd thru 8th place medals Relay events: 18-14-12-10-8-6-4-2

Relay: 1st thru 3rd place medals; 4th thru 8th place ribbons

Club: 1st thru 8th place plaques

High Point: Top scoring athlete at the meet for each gender and age - girls and boys 11, 12, 13, 14 years old

Timers

- Clubs will be assigned timing responsibilities. The Meet Director will notify clubs via email of their timing assignments the week of the meet.
- Time trial athletes and those in the 1650 free and the prelims session of the 1000 free must provide their own timers.

Officials

- We always appreciate the help of certified officials. If you are attending this meet please complete the <u>Application to Officiate</u> which will notify the Meet Referee of your commitment.
- Uniform for officials is:
 - Prelims White shirt over black pants/shorts/skirt, black socks and shoes.
 - Finals White shirt over black pants/knee length skirt, black socks and shoes.
- This meet is designated as a National Qualifying Meet for Officials (OQM). Officials wishing to apply for N2/N3 evaluation are required to submit an application, preferably before commencement of the meet. Early applications are given preference; please complete the <u>Application to Officiate</u> indicating your request for evaluation/mentorship.
