| Entry Deadline | Entries can be sent beginning April 22, 2024, noon. Entries are due no later than 7pm May 2, 2024. No on-deck registration will be permitted. |
| Entry Limit | Swimmers may enter 4 individual events and 1 relay. |
| Meet Format | All events will be pre-seeded and swum mixed gender, slow to fast, as timed finals. No deck entries will be allowed. Age limits/guidelines are designated on the order of events page. |
| Entry Fees | \$9/swimmer (\$3 OSI surcharge and \$6 facility use fee) \$4.50 Individual entry fee per event \$12.00 per relay Please make check payable to HRVST. |

| Entries | Submit short course yard times for seeding. No time entries will be accepted, except for 12 & Under entries in the Open events. Those swimmers must have a 10 yr old B time to enter the Open events. 13 & Overs in the Open events do not have to achieve a qualifying standard. Hytek Meet Management software will be used. Please include a pdf file of entries submitted on email file. |
| Relays | Relays may be swum all girl, all boy, or mixed genders. Relays that don't have either 2 boy & 2 girl, or 4 of the same gender will not have relay times that enter SWIMS. |
| Awards | Ribbons 1-10 th place. Boys and girls are swam together but scored separately. |

| Credentials | Coaches and Officials shall display USA Swimming credentials with current certification when on deck. |
| Timers | The meet will be operated with two timers per lane. Each team will be responsible for assisting with timing. Swimmers in the 500 Free and 1650 Free need to provide their own timers. |
| Times | Facility will open to the public at 8:30am and remain open to the public during the competition. Warm-ups: 9:00-9:45am Officials Meeting: 9:15am Coaches Meeting: 9:45am Meet starts 10:00am |
| Racing Starts | Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming Member Coach as being proficient in performing racing starts or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. |
| Facility | Indoor 10 lane 25 yard by 25 meter pool. 6 to 10 lanes will be used for competition depending on the number of entries. Parking is available at the pool and on adjacent streets. Swim venue includes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Men's & Women's locker rooms with access onto the pool deck. • Open pool deck areas available for swimmers, coaches and officials. • Facility is accessible to adaptive swimmers. • There is bleacher space and room for folding chairs on the deck. • Pool depth is 7 feet at the deep end and 4 feet at the shallow end. • The facility or host will assure that the measurements are accurate. |
| Timing | Colorado Electronic Timing System, horn start and touchpads with button backup will be used. Results via electronic scoreboard. Results will be published to Meet Mobile. |
| Unattached swimmers | For unattached swimmers, or swimmers whose coach is not attending the meet, it is the swimmer's responsibility to arrange for a certified coach to be responsible for the swimmer. This must be done BEFORE the swimmer may enter the water for warm-ups or competition. Please |

| 4 Hour Rule | This meet is planned such that events for 12 & Under swimmers can reasonably be concluded within four (4) hours. The number of entered events will be reduced for all athletes should the 4 hour limit for 12 & U's be exceeded based on entries received. |
