



2025 BOD Meeting - July 02

Meeting Purpose

Approve new junior athlete representative and discuss funding for officials' training at the annual summit.

Key Takeaways

- Yahan Zhang from Lake Oswego approved as new junior athlete representative
- Board approved up to \$750 additional funding for officials' training at annual summit without further approval
- Oregon Swimming secured \$4 million in funding for Osborne pool repairs, with potential reopening in about a year

Topics

New Junior Athlete Representative

- Athletes elected Yahan Zhang from Lake Oswego as junior athlete rep
- Board unanimously approved the election

Officials' Training at Annual Summit

- End of September annual summit includes N2 officials training for better mentoring
- USA Swimming recommends LSC send a representative but isn't covering costs this year
- Estimated cost: ~\$1,000 (previously partially covered by USA Swimming)
- Historical context:
 - USA Swimming used to cover room (shared) and registration
 - LSC covered travel (~\$350-\$400) from official's chair budget
- Current budget situation:
 - Officials' budget has \$1,100 left for travel/education
 - \$5,000 in miscellaneous funds (partly for upcoming Swim Expo)
- Board approved up to \$750 additional funding without further approval

Osborne Pool Funding Update

- Oregon Swimming secured \$4 million in funding for Osborne pool repairs
- Timeline for reopening estimated at about one year
- City manager expressed desire to open Osborne "as soon as possible"
- Final assessment on pool repairs still pending
