| Eligibility: | Swimmers must be currently registered with USA Swimming, and must be within the listed age brackets as of May 18, 2024. No on-deck registration shall be permitted. |
| Entry Deadline: | Final entry deadline is $8: 00 \mathrm{pm}$ on Friday May 10th, 2024, and may close sooner if the meet limit is reached. Team Manager Event file will be available on the OSI website. Entries are open to be received on 4/19/24 |
| Event Limit: | 3 individual events per meet session, 6 events total. |
| Meet Limit: | Entries are accepted on a first-come basis. Swimmer capacity TBD by the Meet Director \& Meet Referee. |
| Entry Fees: | $\$ 18.00$ per swimmer surcharge (includes $\$ 3$ OSI fee and $\$ 15$ facility use fee) $\$ 2.00$ per individual event (includes .50 OSI fee) |

| Entries: | Please submit a Hytek entry file to coachbobbyddac@gmail.com YARD TIMES only for seeding. With submission of entries, the coach-team representative attests that all swimmers entered are registered with USA Swimming. |
| Meet Format: | All events will be swum as timed finals. Relief breaks in the competition may be added at the discretion of the Meet Referee. Over-the-swimmer starts may be used. |
| Facility: | Competition Pool - eight lanes, 7-ft lanes, 25 Yard pool. Depth: The starting block end is 9 feet, the turn end is 3.5 feet. Facility ensures that measurements of the pool are accurate. |
| Seating: | Only parents who are timing are allowed in the starting area. The Parent Spectator Area will be in the colored bleachers, the metal bleachers are for swimmers only. The school facility located north of the aquatic center will be available for swimmers and spectators during the event. |


| Timing: | Daktronics timing system, horn start, and finish touch pads. Results via electronic scoreboard. |

|  | Each team will be given lane timing assignments based on the number of swimmers entered, sign-ups will be in the pool lobby area. |
| Pool Hours: | Pool will be open to meet participants from 7:00 AM until the conclusion of the meet. |
| Awards: | Trophies: $1^{\text {st }}-12^{\text {th }}$ place in each age group ( $8 \& \mathrm{U}, 9-10,11-12,13 \& O v e r$ ). Swimmers must compete in all 6 events to be eligible for a trophy. <br> Trophy presentation will follow the conclusion of Sunday's competition \& inter-tube relays. |
| Scoring: | Accumulated time from all 6 events will decide top finishers for each age group. Disqualifications in an event will add 30 seconds to swimmer's time. Accumulated scores will be posted at the conclusion of Saturdays \& Sundays events. |
| Meetings: | Officials meeting will be held approximately 60 minutes prior to start of each session. Coaches meeting will be held 15 minutes prior to start of each session. |

| 4 Hour Rule: | This meet is planned such that events for 12U's can reasonably be concluded within four (4) hours. |
| Concessions: | Concession items will be provided at the facility, located outside the pool area. |
| Parking/Camping: | Multiple parking lots are available around the Aquatics Center. There is no camping or RV Parking. |
| Rules: | Current USA Swimming and Oregon Swimming, Inc. rules will govern this meet. |
| Safety/Restriction: | Current Oregon Swimming Safety Guidelines and warm-up procedures will be in effect. No tobacco products, alcohol, or glass containers are allowed in the facility. Shaving is not allowed in the venue. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Deck changing is prohibited. Cell phones or other recording devices are not allowed behind the blocks. |
|  | Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing racing starts or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. |

Unaccompanied swimmers must be assigned a coach BEFORE the swimmer may enter the water for warm-ups or competition. It is the swimmers responsibility to arrange, please notify the Meet Director or Referee if assistance is needed.
