Whether submitting entries electronically or on paper, by the action of entering the swimmer in this Wyoming Swimming, Inc. meet/event, the person entering the swimmer, whether a coach, club representative, parent or swimmer, certifies that the swimmer is a registered member of USA Swimming and further agrees that a penalty of \$50 shall be assessed by Wyoming Swimming, Inc. to anyone entering a swimmer who is not registered with USA Swimming prior to the entry deadline.

Pool:

Indoor, 50-meter pool with 8 lanes, equipped with non-turbulent lane markers, starting blocks, & backstroke flags. Pool measures at a minimum depth of 4 feet and a maximum depth of 13 feet, measured for a distance of 3 feet 3 ½ inches (1 meter) to 16 feet 5 inches (5 meters) from both end walls.

The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.

Timing:

Colorado GEN7 Timing System, with 10 lane scoreboard and semi-automatic backup, and two (2) manual back up timers per lane. All clubs will be expected to provide timers based on the number of swimmers their club has participating in the meet.

Rules: Current USA Swimming rules, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), will govern this meet. All adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted behind the blocks, in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.

Flash photography will not be allowed at the start of each race.

Whistle starts will be used. The Meet Referee will have final authority for conduct of the meet. The Meet Referee in concurrence with the Meet Director may combine events in accordance with Section 102.7.2 of the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations.

Eligibility:

No swimmer will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in USA Swimming Article 302.

There will be NO on-deck registrations.

Disabilities:

Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to attend. Contact the Meet Director if you need special consideration. Swimmers with disabilities must be identified at the time entries are submitted. Adaptive swimming: in accordance with USA Swimming rule 202.4.14 & Article 105 the Meet Referee has the authority to accommodate swimmers with disabilities. The Team Entry Representative must notify the Meet Referee and entry contact of accommodation requests at the time of entry submission.

Clerk of Course: There will be no Clerk of Course. Heat and lane assignments will appear in the program. Swimmers are responsible for taking the position behind the blocks.

Age Groups:

Swimmer's age will be determined by his/her age on the first day of the meet, June 14, 2024. This meet is open to swimmers currently registered with USA Swimming.

Events will be swum as 12 & Under, 12 & Over, 11 & Over, 9 & Over, and 13 & Over.

USA Rule 102.1.2 – 8 & UNDER is not a recognized USA Swimming Age Group.

Awards:

Ribbons will be awarded by gender to 1st through 12th place for 8 & Under, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-16 and 17 & Over age groups.

(GST will not mail leftover ribbons.) Please designate someone from your team to stay to pick up ribbons.)

Entries:

All events will be pre-seeded and timed finals.

Each swimmer is limited to a maximum of five (5) individual events per session. Swimmers may not exceed a maximum of eleven (11) individual events.

Please submit entry times in LCM (Long Course Meters).

On-Deck Entries will be accepted only if there is a lane available and the swimmer is either already entered in other events or presents his/her USA registration card.

Late entries will be accepted only at the Meet Director's discretion. If late entries are accepted, they will be charged \$10.00 per event. No additional heats will be created to accommodate late entries.

Scratches: Scratches should be reported in writing to the Meet Director prior to the start of each session.

Entry Fees: \$6.00 per individual event. There is an \$8.00 WYSI participation fee and a \$6.00 per swimmer pool surcharge. There will be no refunds. Payments must accompany entries with check made payable to: **Gillette Swim Team.**

Please include phone numbers and/or email addresses of coaches or club representatives in case any changes or questions arise during the meet entry process.

Each WYSI (Wyoming Swimming, Inc) club shall provide official(s) to work the meet based on the number of swimmers entered into the meet: 1-9 Swimmers – No official required, 10-17 Swimmers – One official, 18-25 Swimmers – Two officials, 26 or more Swimmers – Three officials.

When submitting their entries to the host club, each WYSI club shall also provide to the Referee the names of the official(s) who will be representing their club at the meet.

Within 24 hours of the entry deadline, each host club must email Official's Chair Dayna Gripp at daygripp@mac.com with the MM "Athlete Roster Report by Team" and the list of WYSI officials who will be working at your meet and what WYSI clubs they will be representing.

Warm Ups: Warm up procedures will comply with USA Swimming and Wyoming Swimming, Inc. Dive starts will be allowed

only during the last five (5) to ten (10) minutes of each warm up. USA Swimmers must be under the supervision of a coach at all times. A schedule of warm-up times and lane assignments will be determined after the entry deadline when the number of contestants has been determined. The warm-up schedule will be emailed to all coaches no later

than 2 days prior to the meet.

USA Cards: ALL COACHES & MEET OFFICIALS DISPLAY THEIR MEMBERSHIP CARD VIA THE USA

SWIMMING APP WHEN REQUESTED.

Final Results: Meet results will be emailed to coaches/representatives at the end of the meet. Meet results will also be

available on the WYSI website at www.wyomingswimming.org.
