The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4) the copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming. Colorado Timing System with 8 lane scoreboard with fully automatic timing system, semi-automatic backup and 2 manual back up timers per lane. The meet will be competed in 6 lanes. Warm-up area will be lane 8 with a buffer lane 7 The host will ensure the required course dimensions. **FORMAT: Timed Finals** 25-yard events will start at Starting Block end of the pool and will be timed with (2 watches, electronic) All Clubs will be expected to provide timers based on the number of swimmers their club has participating in the meet The meet will be pre-seeded All events will be competed slow-to-last 1650 and 500 Freestyle must provide their own timers and counters **SCRATCHES** Scratches should be reported in writing to the Meet Director prior to the start of each day **COURSE SCY** ELIGIBILITY All swimmers must be USA Swimming registered members as per Article 302.

DISABILITY SWIMMERS	<ul> <li>Age is determined by the age of the swimmer on the first day of the meet (June 7, 2025)</li> <li>Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.</li> <li>Coaches must be registered and in good standing before the start of the meet.</li> <li>Any club or individual entering a swimmer in a sanctioned meet who is not an Athlete Member in good standing of USA Swimming shall be fined fifty dollars (\$50) for each non-compliant swimmer entered. Such fine shall be payable to WYSI within ten (10) days of notification of the infraction.</li> <li>Deck registrations will NOT be accepted.</li> <li>Athletes with a disability are welcome and shall provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director.</li> </ul>

(Coach's times may be used instead of NT's)</li> <li>Each Swimmer is limited to a maximum of five per day (5) individual events maximum (10) ten individual total events.</li> <li>No Deck entries will be accepted.</li> </ul>

FEES	<ul> <li>\$8 per event fee</li> <li>Swimmer Participation Fee is \$8.00 WYSI per swimmer</li> <li>There are no refunds if a swimmer cannot swim after the USA Swimming Registration File has been sent to WYSI 5 days prior to the meet.</li> </ul>

MEET MOBILE	MEET MOBILE: Meet Mobile will be functional for this meet provided we have satisfactory internet access. All users should be aware that MEET MOBILE publishes UNVERIFIED raw data that may not always be accurate. Results will be posted in the hallway.
WARM-UP	<ul> <li>Dive starts will only be allowed the last five (5) to ten (10) minutes of the warm up session.</li> <li>Warm-up procedures shall follow WYSI Policy III.H.4 and USA Swimming.</li> <li>The Meet Safety Committee shall consist of the Meet Referee, Meet Director and the Host Club Safety Coordinator acting as the Meet Safety Director. This committee shall prepare and implement an action plan to ensure safety is considered during warm-up sessions and swimming competition. The committee shall review the warm-up procedures with the coaches and marshals monitoring the warm-up sessions.</li> <li>Coaches shall supervise their swimmers throughout the pre-meet warmup session. Coaches must remain on deck during the warm-up periods of their swimmers.</li> </ul>
AWARDS	• Individual events will be ribbons for 1 <sup>st</sup> – 8 <sup>th</sup> place and awarded to 8 & Under, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15 and over for each gender

LEGAL SPLITS	3 extra watches required for a legal split time and requested 30 minutes prior to race.
SWIMWEAR	Per USA Swimming rules (102.8.1.F), 12 & Under swimmers may not wear a Technical Suit at any Sanctioned, Approved, or Observed meet. The age of the swimmer is determined on the first

	day of the meet. Guidance on identifying compliant and non-compliant suits can be found on
	the USA Swimming website under <u>Tech Suit Restriction for 12-and-Under Swimmers</u> .
RULES	<ul> <li>The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations including the Minor Athlete Abuse Protection Policy will govern this meet.</li> <li>Operation of a DRONE, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present without written USA Swimming approval.</li> <li>Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. In addition, photography behind the blocks is not permitted.</li> </ul>
CA DECENT	Deck Changing is PROHIBITED.
SAFETY	<ul> <li>No shaving is permitted at the competition site.</li> <li>No glass containers are permitted within the facility.</li> <li>Safety should be everyone's number one priority. Pool decks and locker rooms are slipper please walk.</li> </ul>
	• First Aid boxes and AED devices are available to athletes participating in the meet.
SAFE SPORT	<ul> <li>The USA Swimming Safe Sport program is USA Swimming's comprehensive abuse prevention program dedicated to creating a healthy and positive environment free from abuse for all its members. Components of the program include, but are not limited to, providing education and training, enforcing policies (such as the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy), rules and best practice guidelines, promoting healthy boundaries and mandatory reporting of violations.</li> <li>The Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (www.usaswimming.org/maapp) prohibits Adult Participants (as defined) from having one-on-one interactions with minor athletes which are not within an observable and interruptible distance from another adult participant. CHANGES TO THE MEET	<ul> <li>Once a meet is sanctioned, changes can be made to the meet invitation before the meet, only with the approval of the Sanction Chair. Any change to the meet format after the meet begins will be at the discretion of the Meet Referee and will be presented to the coaches at a coaches meeting.</li> </ul>
WEATHER/ FACILITY PROTOCOL	• If weather or facility conditions make it impossible to follow the original timeline of events, the Meet Director and Meet Referee have a right to make changes to the meet sessions. The Meet Director will notify the teams of the changes with as much notice as possible. Cancellation of the meet, or a session, is the decision of the Meet Director, Meet Referee and the Meet Jury.
MEET JURY	• The Meet Jury shall consist of not fewer than three (3) and not more than five (5) persons, at least one of whom shall be a coach and one an athlete. When possible, the members shall be from separate teams. The Meet Jury will decide all issues of eligibility, and anything not addressed in the Meet Announcement. The Meet Referee shall have authority as described in the current USA Swimming Rulebook.
DECK ACCESS	<ul> <li>Only current USA Swimming registered athletes, coaches, officials, and official meet staff are permitted on the pool deck. All non-athletes on the pool deck must produce proof of their valid USA Swimming Membership Card in the USA Swimming App (no photos or screenshots) when asked.</li> </ul>
OFFICIALS	<ul> <li>Each WYSI team shall provide official(s) to work the meet based on the number of swimmers entered into the meet:         <ul> <li>1-9 Swimmers – No official required,</li> <li>10-17 Swimmers – One official,</li> <li>18-25 Swimmers – Two officials,</li> <li>26 or more Swimmers – Three officials.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Each WYSI team shall provide the names of the official(s) who will be representing their team at the meet at the time their entries are submitted. Failure to provide the required number of officials may result in no awards (medals, ribbons, trophies, high point, etc.) being provided to such Club or its swimmers and an additional fine of \$500.00 payable to the Host Club on or before the first day of the meet.</li> <li>Officials meeting will be 9:15am in the pool multi-purpose room.</li> </ul>
GENERAL	Depending on participation there may be hospitality and concessions for this meet. Water fountains are located between the restrooms across from the locker room entrance in the hallway.
WAIVER	<ul> <li>It is understood and agreed that the Newcastle Stingray Swim Team, Kozisek Aquatic Center, WCSD#1, Wyoming Swimming and USA Swimming shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.</li> </ul>
