# HELD UNDER SANCTION OF WYOMING SWIMMING, INC. AND USA SWIMMING, INC. SANCTION \# 2024-5 

In granting this sanction, it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming, Wyoming Swimming Inc. (WYSI), Laramie Swim Club and Laramie High School Pool shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.

Whether submitting entries electronically or on paper, by the action of entering the swimmer in this WYSI meet/event, the person entering the swimmer, whether a coach, team representative, parent or swimmer certifies that the swimmer is a registered member of USA Swimming and further agrees that a penalty of $\$ 50$ shall be assessed by Wyoming Swimming, Inc. to anyone entering a swimmer who is not registered with USA Swimming prior to the entry deadline.

Meet Time: Friday: Minimum of 1 hour warmup, sessions to be assigned; prior to meet starting at 6:00 PM
Saturday: Minimum of 1 hour warmup, sessions to be assigned; prior to meet starting at 9:45 AM
Sunday: Minimum of 1 hour warmup, sessions to be assigned; prior to meet starting at 9:45 AM
If the number of entries exceeds the recommended time per session (4 hours), a second session for that day may be created at the discretion of the Meet Referee. 12-Under will swim in the morning session starting at 9:45 AM and 13-Over will swim in the afternoon session, start time TBD. A decision on the sessions will be made the day after entries are received. Information will be passed to coaches if and when an afternoon session is created.

Pool: $\quad 25 Y A R D, 10$ Lane Pool equipped with non-turbulent lane markers, starting blocks, \& backstroke flags. At starting end of the pool, the depth is $7^{\prime}$ deep at $3^{\prime} 31^{1 / 2 \prime}$ to $7^{\prime}$ to $14^{\prime}$ deep at $16^{\prime} 5^{\prime \prime}$ from starting end. The pool depth is $14^{\prime}$ deep at $3^{\prime} 31^{\prime} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ from turn end of pool to $7^{\prime}$ to $14^{\prime}$ at $16^{\prime} 5^{\prime \prime}$ from turning end. Altitude is 7315 feet above sea level.

The competition course has been certified in accordance with $104.2 .2 \mathrm{C}(4)$ and is on file with USA Swimming.
Timing: Colorado Timing System, with 10 lane scoreboard, semi-automatic backup, and 2 manual back up timers per lane.

Rules: Current USA Swimming rules, including Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (MAAPP), will govern the meet.
Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Changing into or out of swimsuits, other than in locker rooms is prohibited.
Use of recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.
Operation of a drone or other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue any time people are present.
Eligibility: No swimmer will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in USA Swimming Art 302.

There will be NO on-deck registrations.

Disabilities: Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to attend. Swimmers with disabilities must be identified at the time entries are submitted. Adaptive swimming: in accordance with USA Swimming rule 202.4.14 \& Article 105 the Meet Referee has the authority to accommodate swimmers with disabilities. The Team Entry Representative must notify the Meet Referee and entry contact of accommodation requests at the time of entry submission.

Age Groups: Swimmer's age will be determined by his/her age on the day of the meet, November 10, 2023.

Age groups are 8 -under, 10 -Under, 11-12, 13-14, 15-over. 8-under is not a recognized USA swimming age group
Events will be swum together with varying age groups and mixed genders.

Timed results will be posted by recognized age group and gender.

Relays: Each team may enter as many relays as they want. Please note that there are same gender relays and mixed gender ( 2 male, 2 female) relays. These may be combined and swam as one event.

Scoring: No team scores will be calculated.
Awards: $\quad$ Ribbons will be provided for places 1-6 in each age group for each individual event. Per USA Rule 205.5-Cost per award to an individual may not exceed $\$ 25$.

Entries: All events will be pre-seeded, timed finals, heats will be seeded slowest to fastest.
Each swimmer is limited to a maximum of $\mathbf{5}$ individual events and 2 relays per day.

Please submit entry times in YARDS.

There will be no deck entries, except at the discretion of the Meet Referee.
Entry Fees: WYSI participation Fee is $\$ 8.00$.
Facility surcharge is $\$ 10.00$ per swimmer.
Entry fees are $\$ 4.00$ per individual event and $\$ 5.00$ per relay.
Deadline: Entries must be postmarked or emailed no later than noon, November 3 ${ }^{\text {rd }}, 2023$.

Officials: Each WYSI-affiliated team shall provide official(s) to work the meet based on the number of swimmers entered into the meet: 1-9 Swimmers - No official required, 10-17 Swimmers - One official, 18-25 Swimmers - Two officials, 26 or more Swimmers - Three officials. Each team shall provide the names of the official(s) who will be representing their team at the time their entries are submitted. The Meet Referee will contact officials to inform them of which sessions they will be working depending upon deck requirements.

Officials meetings will start one (1) hour prior to the start of each session (5:00 PM on Friday, 8:45 AM on Saturday and Sunday). The uniform for this meet will be black pants or shorts, black shoes/socks, and a white shirt. Additional information for officials will be passed via email.

Warm-Ups: Warm-ups will comply with USA Swimming and WYSI procedures. Swimmers must be under coach supervision at all times. Warm-up schedules will be emailed no later than 3 days prior to the meet.

Timers: Clubs will be assigned lanes for timing proportionate to the number of swimmers they have entered. If smaller clubs have specific requests for certain sessions, please include that information with your entries. Please have your timers ready to go!

USA Cards: ALL COACHES \& MEET OFFICIALS MUST WEAR THEIR USA SWIMMING CARD IN PLAIN VIEW AT ALL TIMES OR AVAILABLE VIA DECK PASS.
