

WYSI report October 13.

During the HOD meeting (end of August), someone asked about the diving progressions checklist. I told everyone it was on the Operational Risk Web Page. (USASwimming.org – then click on “about” then “operational risk”) It was taken off so I called Colorado Springs and had them put it back on. The checklist is back on the USA swimming operational risk site and on our Wyoming Swimming Operational Risk website.

Please make sure that coaches are doing this diving progressions checklist every new session of swimming.

That document requires that for swimmers age 10 years and under or swimmers with less than one year of experience, the coach must certify that the swimmer has been trained according to the progression set forth on the form. (That progression is based on the revised Safety Training Manual). For older or more experienced swimmers, the checklist requires the coach to certify appropriate skill level based on the coach’s observation. The required certification is based on the coach’s professional judgment and must be recorded in writing for each swimmer.
