









# 2025 14 & Under Midwest All Star Championships

IASI SANCTION:	IA-25-26 Held under the sanction of USA Swimming and Iowa Swimming, Inc. (IASI).			
INVITED LSC'S:	Colorado, Iowa, Midwestern, Missouri Valley, North Dakota, South Dakota			
RULES:	Current USA Swimming and IASI technical and administrative rules, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), will govern this meet. Each LSC will participate as an All Star team based upon its own team selection process. Each LSC is allowed up to 12 swimmers per gender per age group. Each LSC is allowed up to three (3) relays per relay event (use aggregate time for entry time).			
DATES:	Saturday and Sunday, January 11 & 12, 2025.			
TIME:	All swimmers, coaches, and meet volunteers must enter the building using the lower-level Grand Avenue entrance. Spectator seating will oper at each session's warm-up start time with spectators required to enter on the second level skywalk entrance to the pool.

	This is a pre-seeded timed final meet. Sessions may be divided between two pools if needed to accommodate the maximum number of entries. Instructions for check-in and warm-up assignments will be distributed to team contacts by 5:00 pm Wednesday, January 8 <sup>th</sup> and posted on the event website.  A Coaches meeting will be held at 5:00 pm on Friday, January 10 <sup>th</sup> in the wet classroom. It is the coaches' responsibility to acquaint themselves			

	with all information contained in this meet announcement and any information or changes discussed at the coaches' meeting.				
	Officials' meetings will start 1 hour prior to competition each session.

FACILITY:	The Prairie Meadows Pool (competition pool) is a 20 lane 25-yard short course pool with one moveable bulkhead allowing for an 8 lane 50-meter long course pool or multiple configurations when running short course competition(s). Water depth of the pool ranges from 10 feet 8 inches to 7 feet (minimum 5 feet required at start end). Lane width is 8 feet 3 inches.				
	A 4 lane, 25 yard program pool will be available for warm-up if needed.				
	Colorado electronic timing systems will be used.				
	The meet host will ensure the required course dimensions.				
COACHES:	Only currently registered USA Swimming coach members will permitted on deck in designated areas. Each coach must sign to Coaches Meet Sign- In (APP-29) to verify that all certifications a current.				
	Coaches and Officials must produce proof of membership via USA Swimming App or USA Swimming website upon request by the Referee or his delegate or leave the pool deck. Screenshots of a member's card is not acceptable proof of membership.				
WARM UPS:	The IASI mandatory warm-up procedure will be followed.				
	All swimmers must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member- coach during warm-up, competition, and warm-down.				
	Facility rules require a 3 point, feet first, sit and slide entry for lanes designated for circle swim during warm-up and warm-down.				
RACING STARTS:	All swimmers entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge.				

# ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Swimmers must be currently registered as athlete members of USA Swimming.
- 2. Swimmers must enter in the age group events corresponding to age as of January 11, 2025.
- 3. Swimmers may enter as many events for which they have qualifying times, but must scratch down to no more than two individual events per session by the scratch deadline, Failure to scratch down will result in the swimmer only being seeded in the first two events for the session that they are entered.
- 4. Seed times must be submitted for a 25-yard course (SCY). Swimmers must have achieved a USA Swimming 2024-2028 Motivational Standard BB time for all entered events. Converted times are not allowed.

#### **ENTRY LIMITS:**

- 1. A swimmer may participate in up to two (2) events PER SESSION with a maximum of six (6) events total for the meet plus relays.
- 2. LSCs may enter more than five (5) swimmers per event. Only 5 are eligible to score.
- 3. LSCs may enter up to three (3) relay teams per relay event. Only 2 relays are eligible to score.
- 4. LSCs may have teams NO LARGER than 72 athletes (24 per age group, 12 male and 12 female, 10&U, 11-12, 13-14).

### ENTRY SUBMISSION:

Entry fees are as follows:

- 1. \$10.00 per individual event. \$16.00 per relay
- 2. IASI swimmer surcharge: \$6.00 per swimmer. The surcharge is not assessed to outreach swimmers who qualify for LSC benefits.
- 3. Facility Use Fee: \$15.00 per swimmer
- 4. The entry for each outreach swimmer who qualify for LSC benefits is \$5.00 and covers all individual entry fees, facility use fees, and the IASI surcharge.

Entries must be submitted in electronic format (meet entry file with hard copy). A check for the entry fees must accompany all entries. Any swimmer in relays only will be listed on the roster and the IA swimmer surcharge Fee and Facility Use Fee paid for that swimmer.

Submit entries along with the appropriate IASI Financial Sheet (APP-8.1). If submitting electronic entries, also send a hardcopy of the entries with the entry fees and financial sheet.

LSCs entering outreach swimmers should only provide the number of outreach swimmers and the number of events being swum by the outreach swimmers to the host club and verified by the IASI

	Administrative office according to IASI Outreach policy. The names of the outreach swimmers are not to be provided to the host club.  Payment shall be by check or money order made payable to <b>Greater Des Moines YMCA</b> . All entry fees, including IASI swimmer surcharge fees, should be combined on one check. The host club reserves the right to require payment by money order or cashier's check. Entry fees are non-refundable; IASI swimmer surcharge fees will be refunded only if the entire meet is cancelled.
ENTRY DATES AND DEADLINES:	<ol> <li>The meet entry deadline is 8:00 pm on Friday, January 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2025.</li> <li>Psych sheets will be sent to the LSC Entry Chair within 24 hours of the entry deadline.</li> <li>LSCs have until 5:00 pm on Monday, January 6<sup>th</sup>, 2025 to submit changes. This is the scratch and late entry deadline.</li> <li>A hard or pdf copy of each LSC's entries, along with entry fees and financial sheet, must be received by Wednesday, January 8<sup>th</sup>, 2025 unless prior arrangements have been agreed to in writing. Failure to meet this deadline will result in swimmers remaining in the meet but all confirmed entries will be billed at the late entry fee. Any unpaid balance remaining at the start of competition for the final session will be assessed an additional 10% late fee. Team commlink final results will not be emailed until full payment plus any additional fees are paid in full by the team.</li> <li>Entries will be confirmed via a return email receipt.</li> <li>Entries will NOT be accepted by phone or fax.</li> </ol>
LATE ENTRIES:	<ol> <li>Only swimmers already entered into the meet who have not reached their session limit will be able to late-enter events after 5:00 pm on Monday, January 6<sup>th</sup>, 2025.</li> <li>For questions regarding late entries or to find out if late entries are being accepted, contact the Meet Entry Chairperson, Kerry Barnes.</li> </ol>
SWIMMERS WITH DISABILITIES:	Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to compete. The Information Form for Adapted Competitive Swimmers (APP-21) indicating limitations, accommodations, and requested modifications should be completed and attached to the meet entries. Modifications will be determined by the Referee. The swimmer (or swimmer's coach) is responsible for providing any equipment or assistants required. See Article 105 of USA Swimming Rules and Regulations.

AWARDS:	Individual Events: 1st thru 3rd Relays: 1st Place only High Point: Each age group and gender, 1st & 2nd Awards will be distributed to coaches at the conclusion of the meet.		
SCRATCHES:	<ol> <li>There is no penalty if a swimmer failes to swim an entered event (No Show (NS) or Declared False Start (DFS), Swimmers andcoaches are encouraged to declare a false start to the referee if a swimmer does not intend to swim an entered event. NSs and DFSs are considered entries for entry limits.</li> <li>The scratch deadline is 5:00 pm Monday, January 6<sup>th</sup>, 2025.</li> </ol>

USA SWIMMING REGISTRATION:	No USA Swimming registrations will be accepted at the meet. Any swimmer who is not a currently registered athlete member at the time of pre-meet reconciliation must ensure that their LSC has received the appropriate application and fees at least 24 hours prior to the start of competition. Failure to do so will result in the swimmer's entries being scratched and the swimmer barred from entering the pool.		
CAMERAS:	USE OF AUDIO OR VISUAL RECORDING DEVICES, INCLUDING CELL PHONES, IS NOT PERMITTED AT ANY TIME IN CHANGING AREAS, RESTROOMS, OR LOCKER ROOMS.		
NO ALCOHOL OR TABACCO:	The use of any tobacco or alcohol products is prohibited in the swimming venue.		
IMAGE RELEASE:	Participants consent to be photographed/filmed by any authorized photographer(s) and/or network(s) of IASI and/or the host club under conditions determined by the host club, and authorize the use of names, pictures, likenesses, and biographical information before, during or after the event to promote swimming. No awards received in this competition may be used for trade or financial gain.		
MEET CONDUCT:	Attending clubs, swimmers and spectators are the guests of the Wellmark YMCA. Any report of inappropriate behavior will be dealt with immediately. DSMY / Wellmark YMCA Staff reserve the right to remove any offending individuals or groups. Any swimmer found swimming under the bulkhead will be ejected from the facility and be barred for the remainder of the meet.		
	Clubs/LSC's will be financially responsible for any damage to the premises caused by their club/team, swimmers and/or parents & spectators.		

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:	1. Program: Heat sheets will be uploaded to the DSMY website www.dsmymarlins.com by 12:00 pm Friday, January 10 <sup>th</sup> , 2025 and uploaded to Meet Mobile prior to each session starting.		
	2. Results: Electronic results will be provided to all teams participating in the meet once full payment and any additional fees for final payment are received. Final results will also be posted on IASI website. A hardcopy of the final results may be requested on the IASI Financial Sheet for an additional \$5.00.		
	3. Concessions: There will be a concession stand located in the southwest corner of the upper concourse in spectator seating. A hospitality room will be available for coaches and officials.		
	4. Swim apparel/merchandise: Elsmore Swim Shop will be onsite offering a variety of swimming apparel and equipment. Fine Designs will also be on site offering customized event merchandise.		
	5. Seating/Spectator Information: There is no charge for admission. Free Wi-Fi is available.		
	6. Deck: Only registered swimmers, coaches and meet personnel will be allowed on deckThere is on deck seating for more than 300 swimmers. Glass containers of any kind are not permitted on the pool deck or spectator area at any time.		
	7. Parking information: Parking meters charge from 9am to 9pm Monday thru Saturday. The 5 <sup>th</sup> & Keo Parking Garage is closest to the facility and provides Skywalk access. There is a charge for parking downtown on Saturdays.		
MAAPP:	All adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.		
MEDICAL SUPERVISION:	Lifeguards on duty will supervise all warmup, competition, and cool down swimming and must be present whenever the pool deck is open. AED devices are available on premises. Lifeguards are Red Cross trained in CPR for the Emergency Response Personnel. Emergency buttons located near the pool which summon additional emergency response including Des Moines Fire Department medical responders.		
INDEMNITY:	It is understood and agreed that USA Swimming and IASI shall be free and held harmless from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.
